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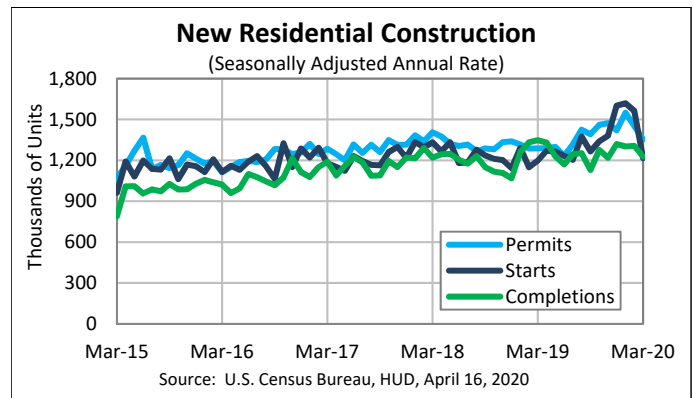
## MONTHLY NEW RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION, MARCH 2020

Release Number: CB20-61

**Statement Regarding COVID-19 Impact:** Due to recent events surrounding COVID-19, many governments and businesses are operating on a limited capacity or have ceased operations completely. The Census Bureau has monitored response and data quality and determined estimates in this release meet publication standards. **April 16, 2020** - The U.S. Census Bureau and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development jointly announced the following new residential construction statistics for March 2020:

### Building Permits

Privately-owned housing units authorized by building permits in March were at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 1,353,000. This is 6.8 percent ( $\pm 1.1$  percent) below the revised February rate of 1,452,000, but is 5.0 percent ( $\pm 2.4$  percent) above the March 2019 rate of 1,288,000. Single-family authorizations in March were at a rate of 884,000; this is 12.0 percent ( $\pm 1.9$  percent) below the revised February figure of 1,005,000. Authorizations of units in buildings with five units or more were at a rate of 423,000 in March.

### Housing Starts

Privately-owned housing starts in March were at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 1,216,000. This is 22.3 percent ( $\pm 12.2$  percent) below the revised February estimate of 1,564,000, but is 1.4 percent ( $\pm 12.7$  percent)\* above the March 2019 rate of 1,199,000. Single-family housing starts in March were at a rate of 856,000; this is 17.5 percent ( $\pm 13.1$  percent) below the revised February figure of 1,037,000. The March rate for units in buildings with five units or more was 347,000.

### Housing Completions

Privately-owned housing completions in March were at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 1,227,000. This is 6.1 percent ( $\pm 12.0$  percent)\* below the revised February estimate of 1,307,000 and is 9.0 percent ( $\pm 12.4$  percent)\* below the March 2019 rate of 1,348,000. Single-family housing completions in March were at a rate of 863,000; this is 15.0 percent ( $\pm 11.6$  percent) below the revised February rate of 1,015,000. The March rate for units in buildings with five units or more was 357,000.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

In interpreting changes in the statistics in this release, note that month-to-month changes in seasonally adjusted statistics often show movements which may be irregular. It may take three months to establish an underlying trend for building permit authorizations, six months for total starts, and six months for total completions. The statistics in this release are estimated from sample surveys and are subject to sampling variability as well as nonsampling error including bias and variance from response, nonreporting, and undercoverage. Estimated relative standard errors of the most recent data are shown in the tables. Whenever a statement such as “2.5 percent ( $\pm 3.2$  percent) above” appears in the text, this indicates the range (-0.7 to +5.7 percent) in which the actual percentage change is likely to have occurred. All ranges given for percentage changes are 90 percent confidence intervals and account only for sampling variability. If a range does not contain zero, the change is statistically significant. If it does contain zero, the change is not statistically significant; that is, it is uncertain whether there was an increase or decrease. The same policies apply to the confidence intervals for percentage changes shown in the tables. On average, the preliminary seasonally adjusted estimates of total building permits, housing starts and housing completions are revised 2.1 percent or less.
