
AMERICAN SAMOA SNAPSHOT

The Economic Census of Island Areas provides detailed data on Sales and other measures of business output for nearly every sector of the economy at the national, state, and local area levels by 2-thru 6-digit NAICS code.



(Note: excludes the Utilities, Information, and Finance and Insurance sectors where state-level revenue data are not published)

Detailed data on Employment and Annual Payroll are also available. For the Manufacturing sector, these data are broken out for production workers and other staff. Data on production worker hours are also provided.


The Retail Trade sector had the most employees of any sector in American Samoa in 2012 (1,435)

The Health Care and Social Assistance sector reported the highest annual payroll of any sector in American Samoa in 2012 (\$20.8 million)



The Economic Census of Island Areas is conducted every 5 years, on the years ending in "2" and "7". Data are shown for comparable industries back to 2002.
