

Survey of Minority-Owned Business Enterprises (SMOBE)

Asians and Pacific Islanders

SMOBE Overview

- Provides only comprehensive source of data on minority-owned business enterprises.
- Data needed to evaluate the extent and growth of business ownership and to provide a framework for assessing and directing private and government programs.

History

- SMOBE first conducted in 1969 in response to executive order.
- → Incorporated into the economic census in 1972.

Scope and Coverage

- → Virtually all nonfarm businesses with greater than \$1,000 in receipts
 - Full coverage of corporations was added in 1997.
 - Prior to 1997 only subchapter S corporations, partnerships, and sole proprietorships were included.

Scope and Coverage

Race and Ethnicity

- Definitions for race and ethnicity defined by OMB Federal Directive 15, issued 1978
 - * Race
 - American Indian or Alaska Native
 - Asian or Pacific Islander
 - Black
 - White
 - * Ethnicity
 - Hispanic Origin
 - Not of Hispanic Origin

Scope and Coverage

→ Gender

- For the 1997 survey, gender was defined as:
 - * Male
 - * Female
 - * Equally male and female
 - * Other (includes publicly held, foreign-owned, and not for profit businesses)

Publications

→ 1997 products were released starting March 2001.

- Seven Publications
 - Women released
 - Black released
 - Hispanic released
 - Asians and Pacific Islanders released
 - American Indians and Alaska Natives released
 - Minority Summary
 - Company Summary

Improvements for 1997

- Inclusion of all corporations
- Ownership based on race, ethnicity, and gender of 51% or greater
- Improved sample design
- Addition of equally male- and female-owned category for gender
- State by 2-digit SIC data available

Improvements for 1997

Fully inclusive estimates

- In reports prior to 1997, estimates for minority-owned business enterprises for a part of the sample could not be allocated by industry and geography and were, therefore, not included in the detailed tables of the reports.
- For 1997, the estimates for all levels of the data include all firms owned by the race and ethnic groups presented.

Improvements for 1997


- Separate publication for American Indians and Alaska Natives
- Separate publication for Asians and Pacific Islanders
- Data tabulated by firm in each industry and geography
- Company Summary report
- → Data free on internet
- → Improved CD-ROM software

Growth of Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms

- The number of Asian- and Pacific Islander-owned firms grew 30% from 1992 to 1997.
 - The number of all U.S. firms grew 7%.
- The receipts of Asian- and Pacific Islander-owned firms grew 68%.
 - The receipts of all U.S. firms grew 40%.

(Includes sole proprietorships, partnerships, and subchapter S corporations)

Percent Distribution of All U.S. Firms by Industry Division: 1997





Percent Distribution of Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms by Industry Division: 1997



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
Percent of Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms and Receipts by Minority Group: 1997



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
Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms as a Percent of Total Firms in State: 1997



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Average Receipts Per Firm by Industry Division for Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms Compared to All U.S. Firms: 1997





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Five States With Largest Number of Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms

- California 316,048
- → New York 123,258
- → Texas 60,226
- → Hawaii 50,634
- **→** New Jersey 41,432

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Five MAs With Largest Number of Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms

- Los Angeles-Long Beach, CA 114,462
- New York, NY 101,814
- Orange County, CA 44,840
- → Honolulu, HI 39,252
- San Francisco, CA 35,427

Size of Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms With Paid Employees

- ⇒ 289,999 (31.8%) Asian- and Pacific Islanderowned firms had paid employees.
- ⇒ 2,084 (0.7% of firms with paid employees) Asianand Pacific Islander-owned firms had 100 or more employees.
- → 145,331 (50.1% of firms with paid employees) had 1 to 4 employees.

Size of Asian- and Pacific Islander-Owned Firms

- → Of all 912,960 Asian- and Pacific Islander-owned firms, 45,252 (5%) had more than \$1,000,000 in receipts.
- → 151,751 (17%) had less than \$5,000 in receipts.

Legal Form of Organization

- The majority (71%) of Asian- and Pacific Islander-owned firms were sole proprietorships.
 - 648,337 firms
- Largest receipts group was the C corporations with 47% of all Asian- and Pacific Islander-owned firms' receipts.
 - Accounted for almost \$146 billion
