2019 Manufacturing Day: International Trade

A Snapshot of Monthly Manufacturing Statistics in the United States



The U.S. International Trade in Goods and Services report, produced jointly by the U.S. Census Bureau and the Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA), is the official source for U.S. import and export statistics. The report provides detailed trade data that are vital for informed decision-making in both the private and public sectors.

The graph below shows the top domestic exports of manufactured goods from January 2017 to July 2019. In July 2019, Transportation Equipment, the top export industry, accounted for about 22.4 percent of all domestic exports of manufactured goods. July 2019 domestic exports of Transportation Equipment were \$20.5 billion, up 12.0 percent from July 2018.

(Not seasonally adjusted)



Auto exports, a major component of Transportation Equipment, are shown below. In July 2019, domestic exports of motor vehicles and motor vehicle parts were \$4.7 billion and \$3.6 billion, respectively.
