

2020 Manufacturing Day: International Trade

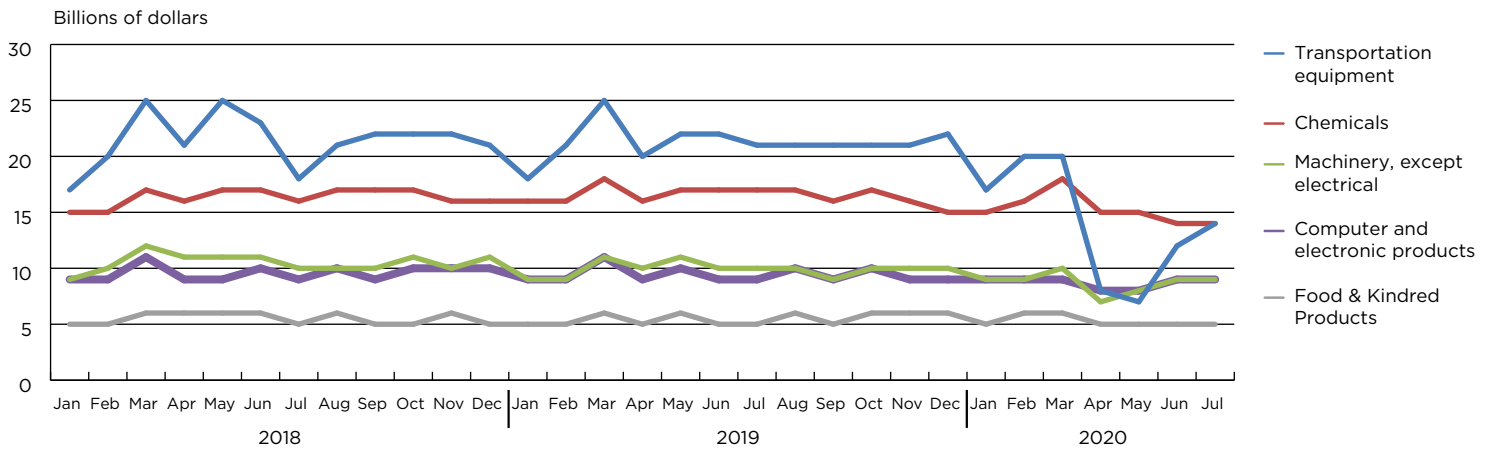
A Snapshot of Monthly Manufacturing Statistics in the United States

Released October 2, 2020

The U.S. International Trade in Goods and Services report, produced jointly by the U.S. Census Bureau and the Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA), is the official source for U.S. import and export statistics. The report provides detailed trade data that are vital for informed decision-making in both the private and public sectors.

The graph below shows the top domestic exports of manufactured goods from January 2018 to July 2020. In July 2020, Transportation Equipment, the top export industry, accounted for about 18.9 percent of all domestic exports of manufactured goods. July 2020 domestic exports of Transportation Equipment were \$14.3 billion, down 30.6 percent from July 2019.

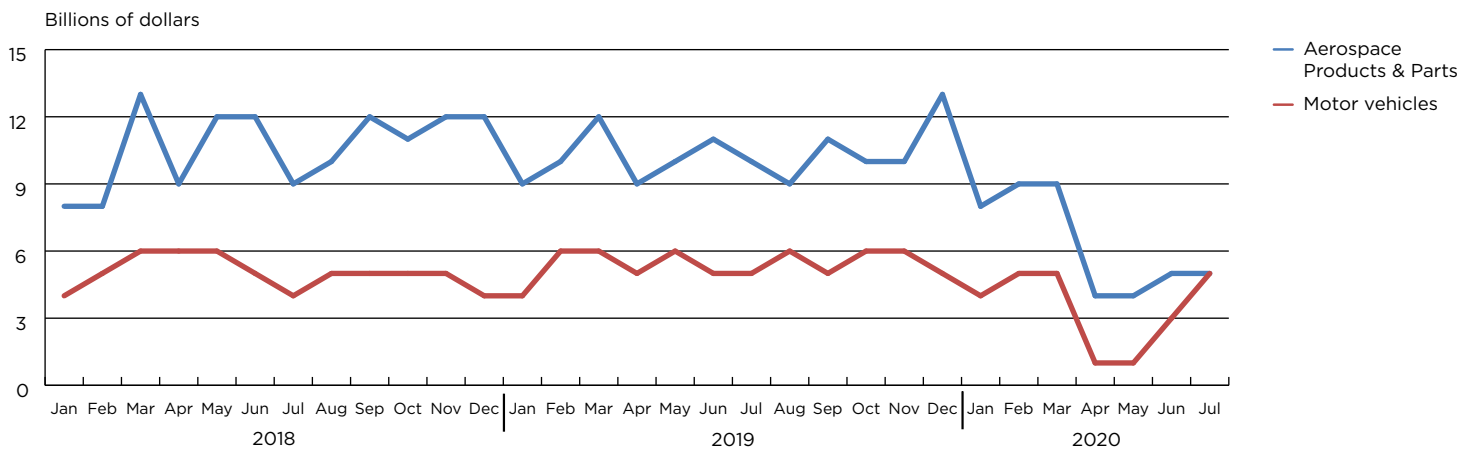
Top 5 Domestic Exports of Manufactured Goods Categories

Aerospace products & parts and motor vehicles, a major part of Transportation Equipment, are shown in the graph below. In July 2020, domestic exports of aerospace products & parts and motor vehicles were \$5.1 billion and \$4.7 billion, respectively.
