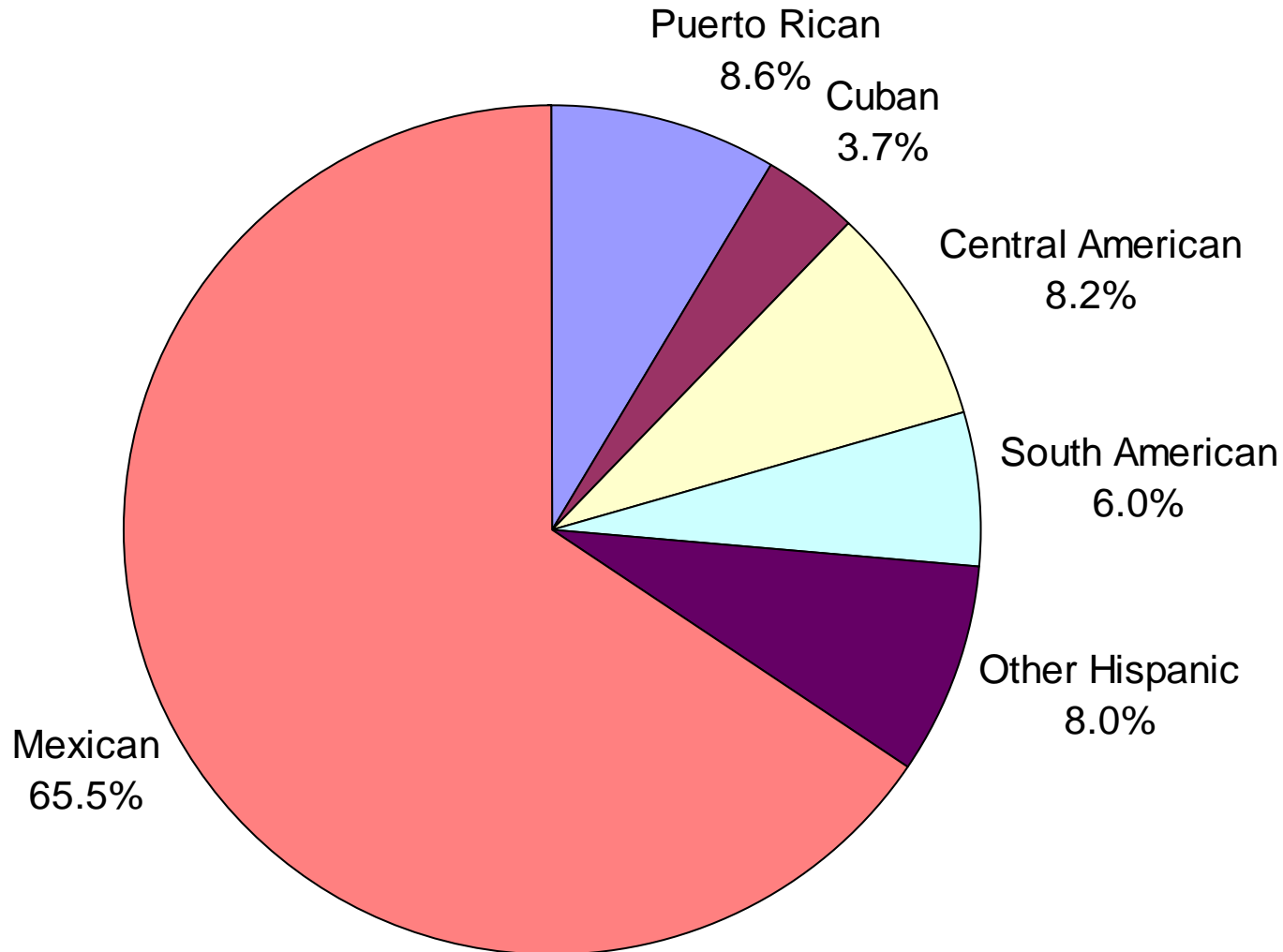

Population Size and Composition

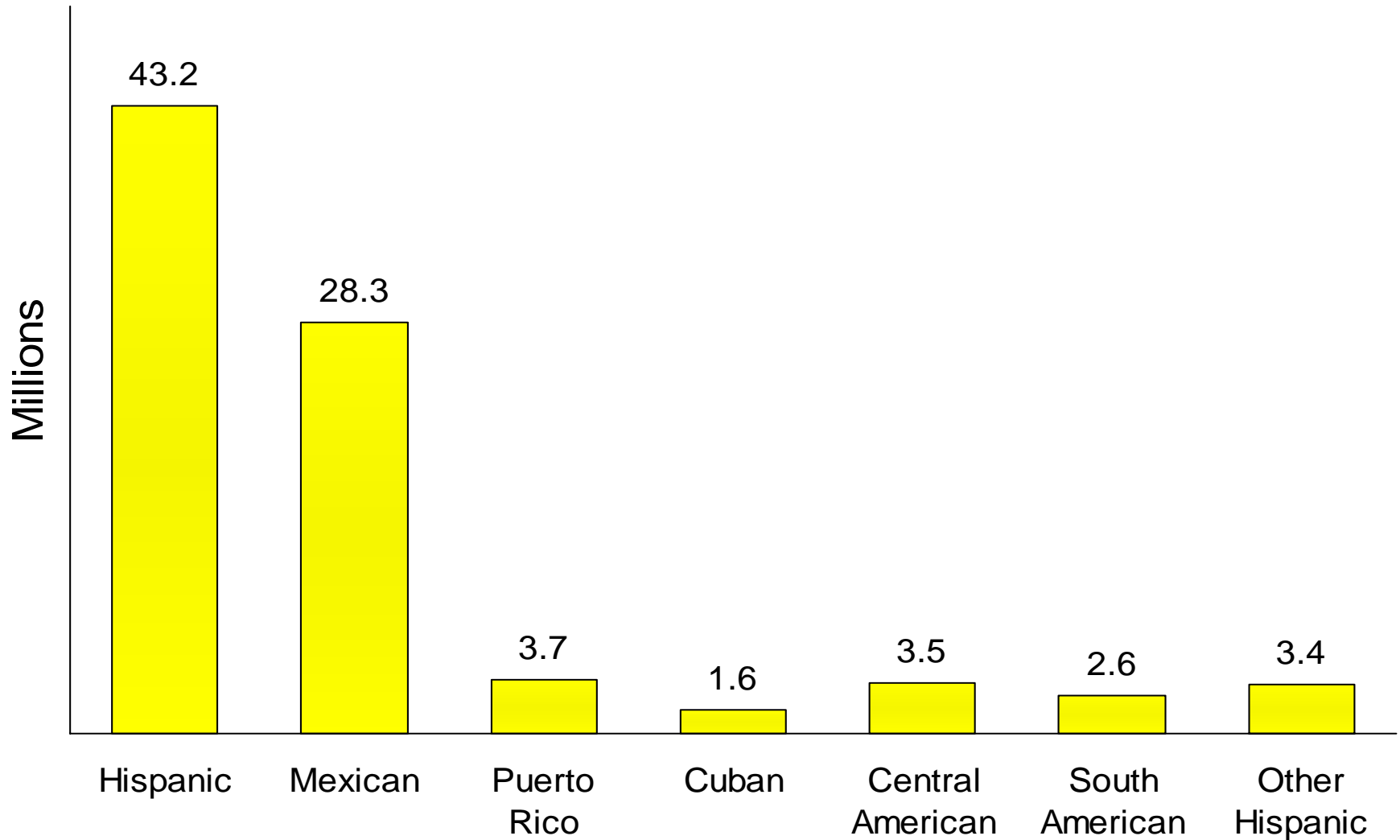
Percent Distribution of Hispanics by Type: 2006

Hispanic Population by Type: 2006

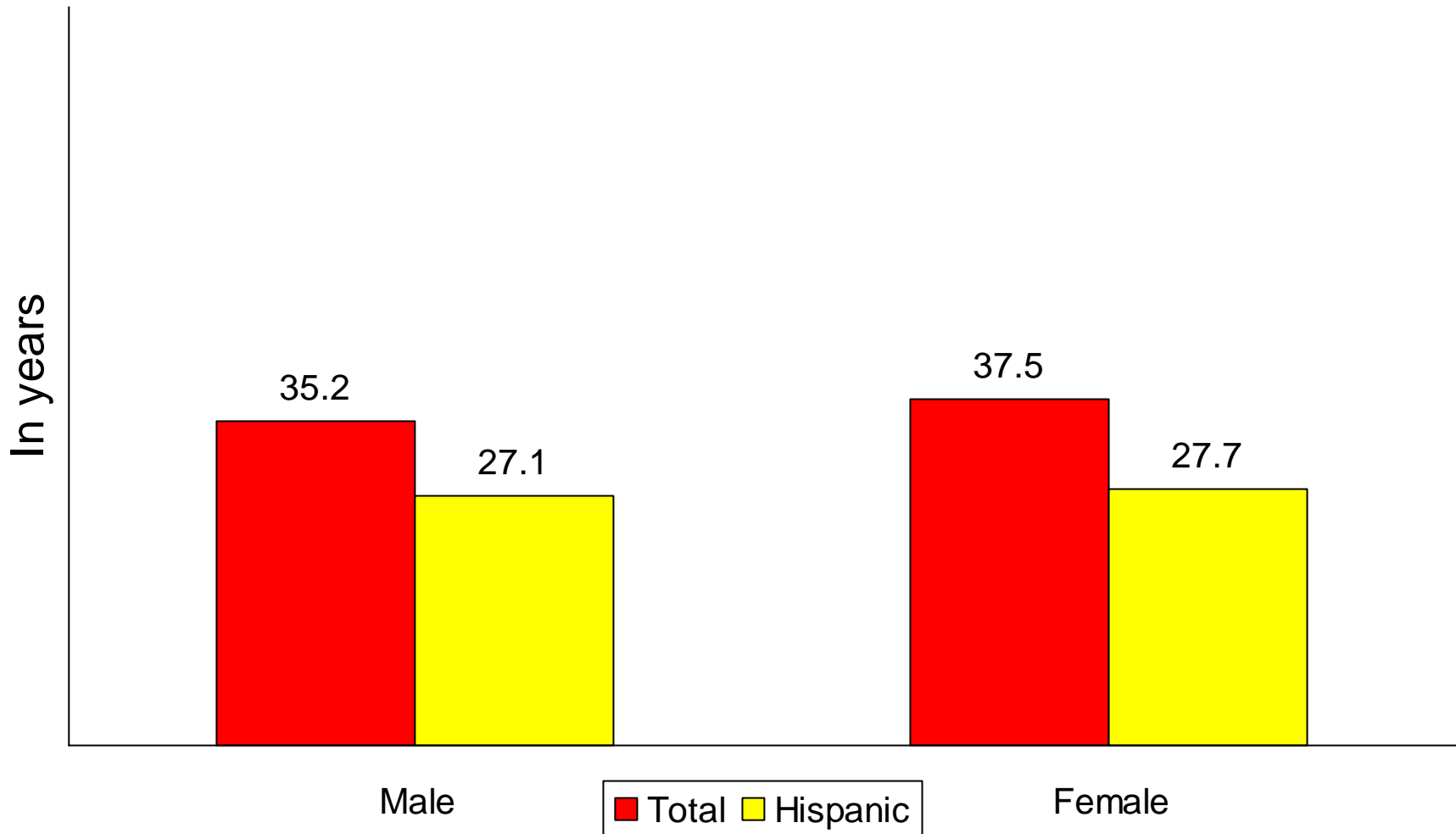

Age and Nativity

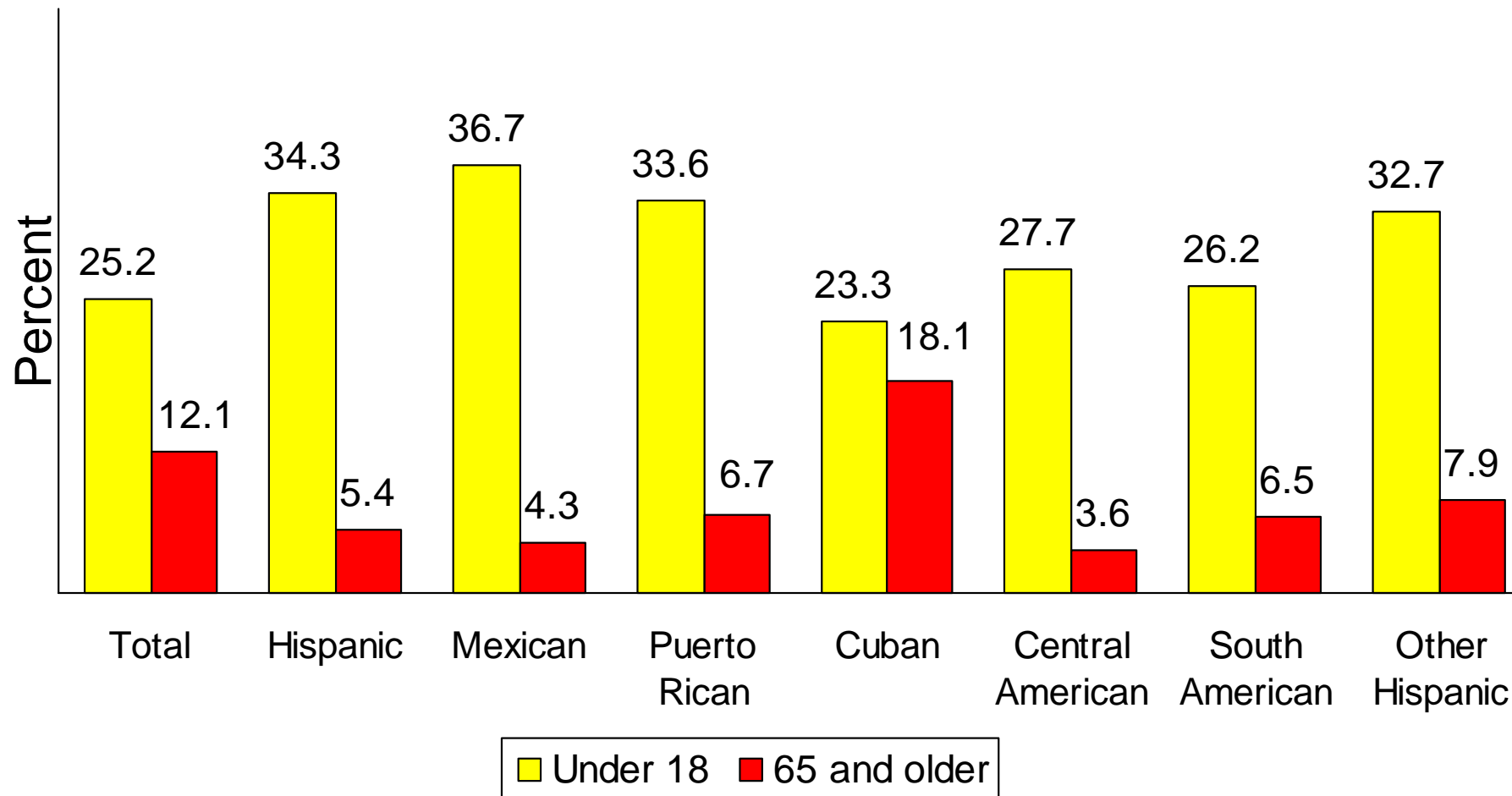

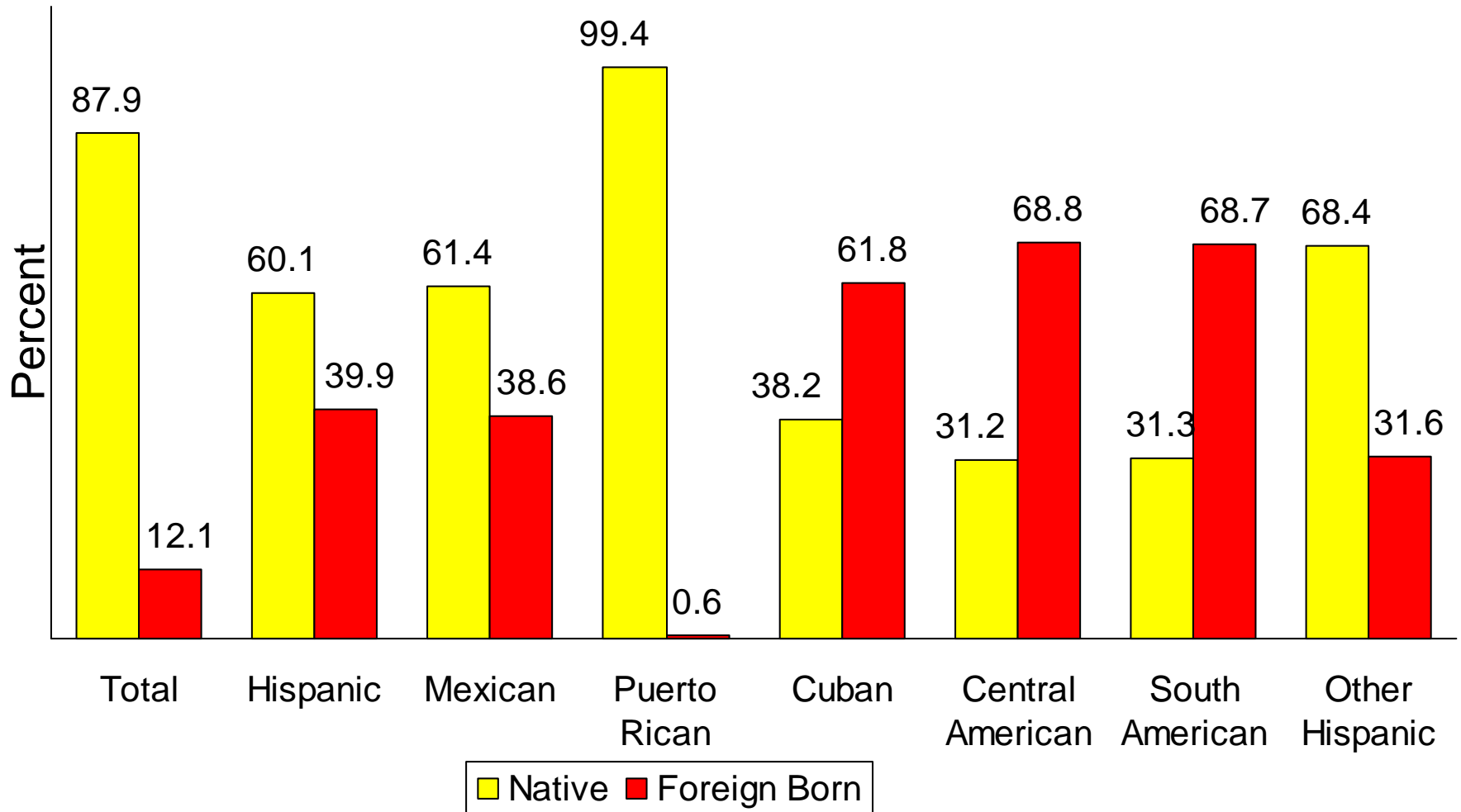
Selected Age Groups by Type of Hispanic Origin: 2006

Nativity by Type of Hispanic Origin: 2006

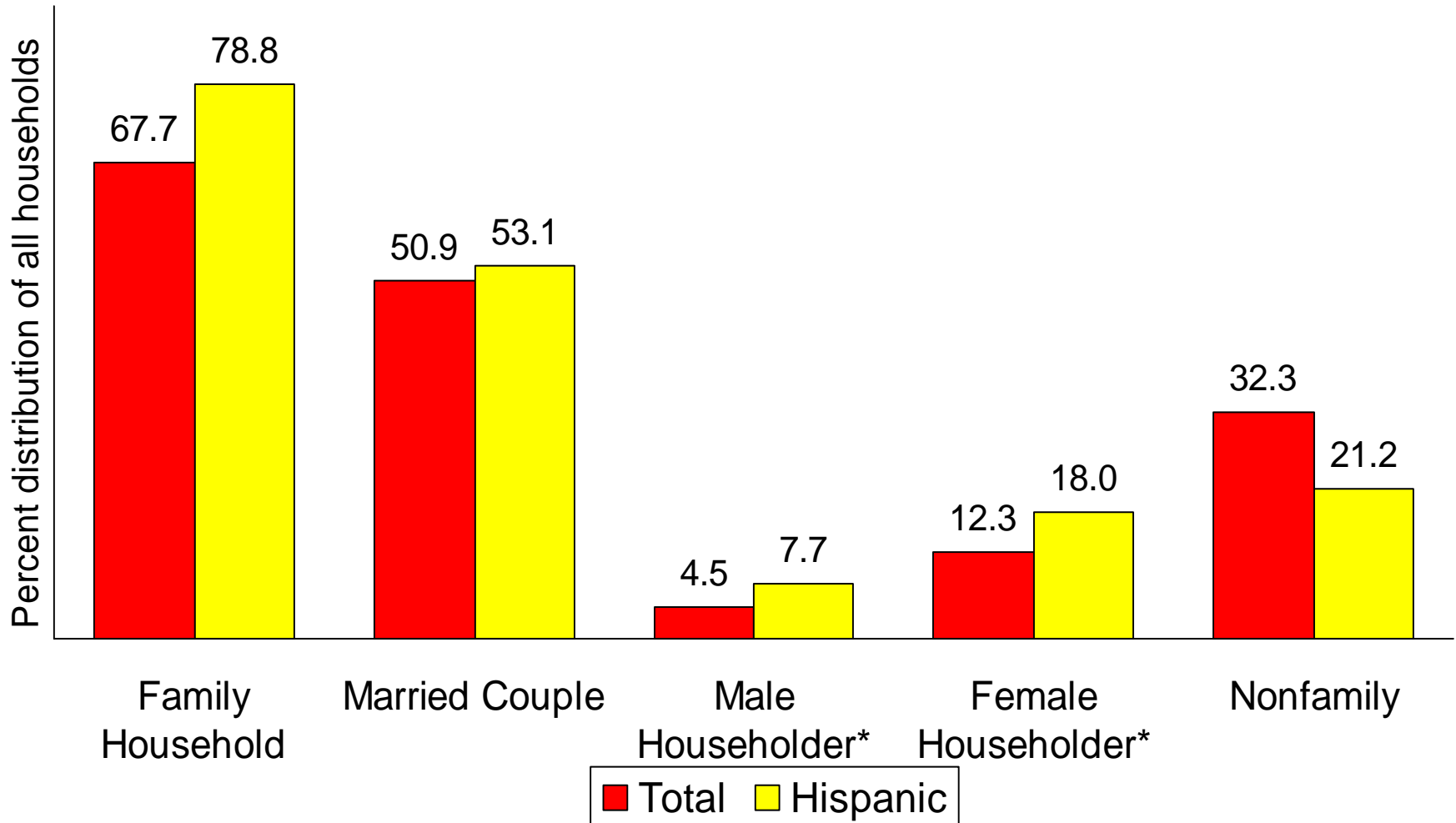

Households by Type and Hispanic Origin: 2006



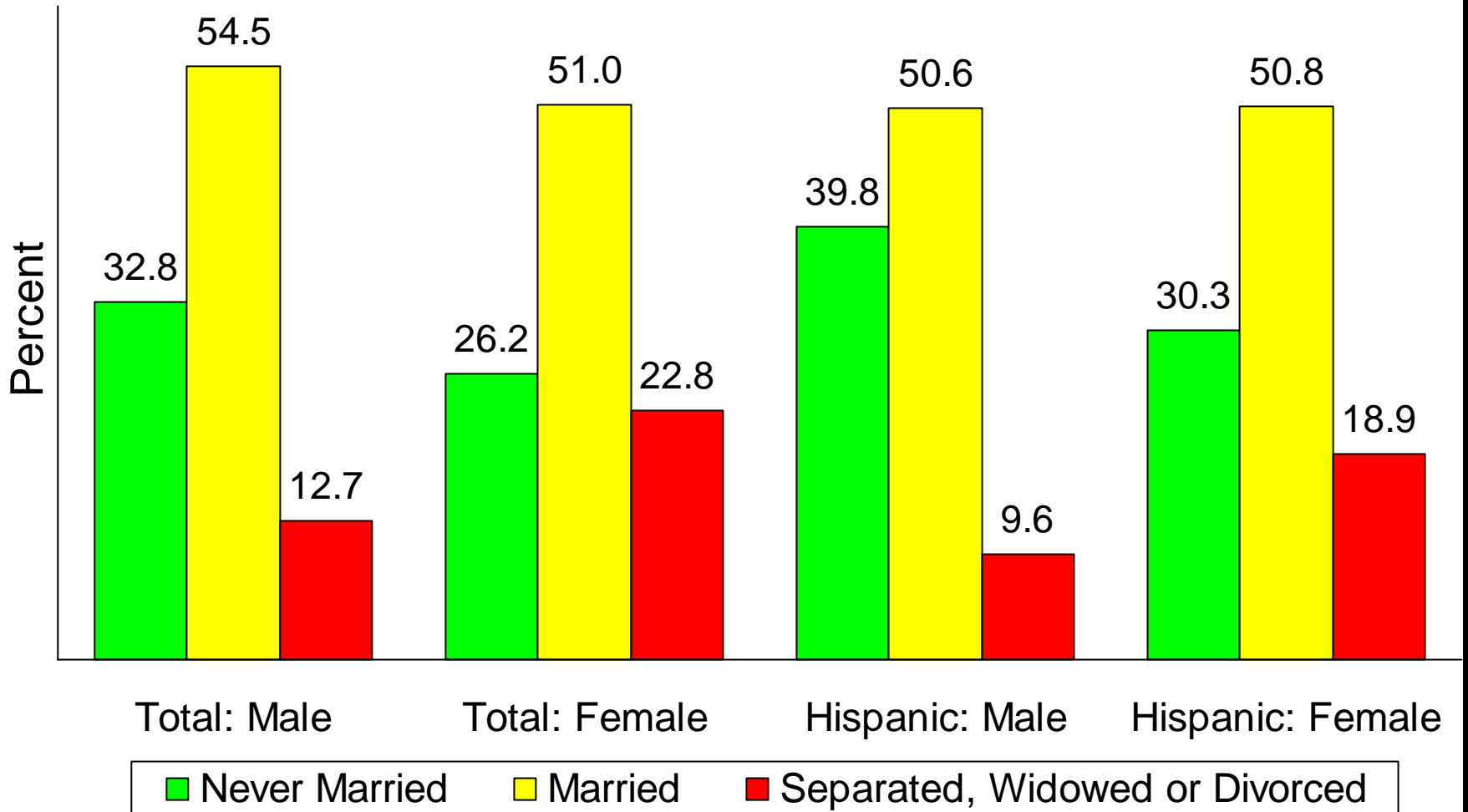

(Percent distribution of population 15 years and over)

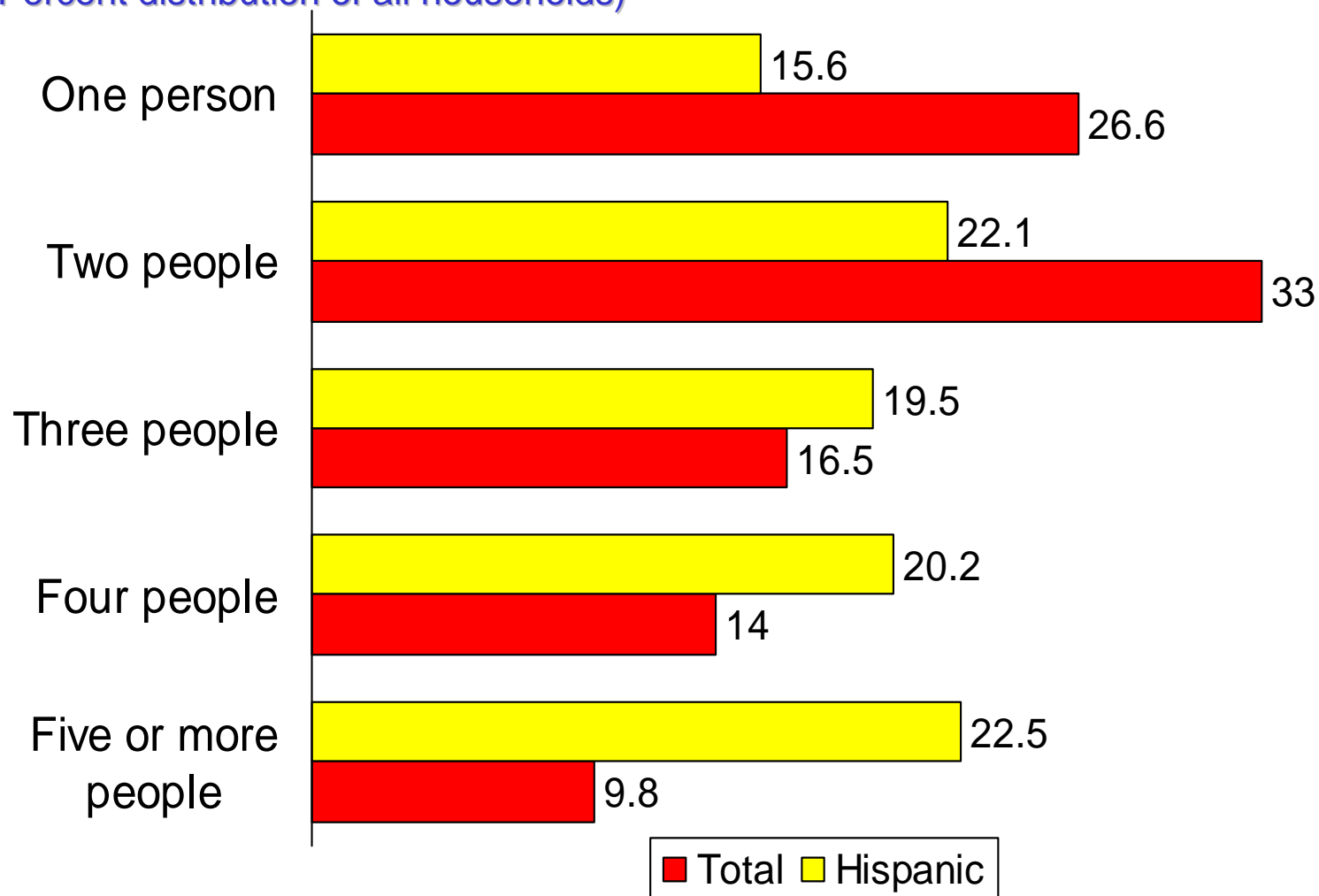

(Percent distribution of all households)



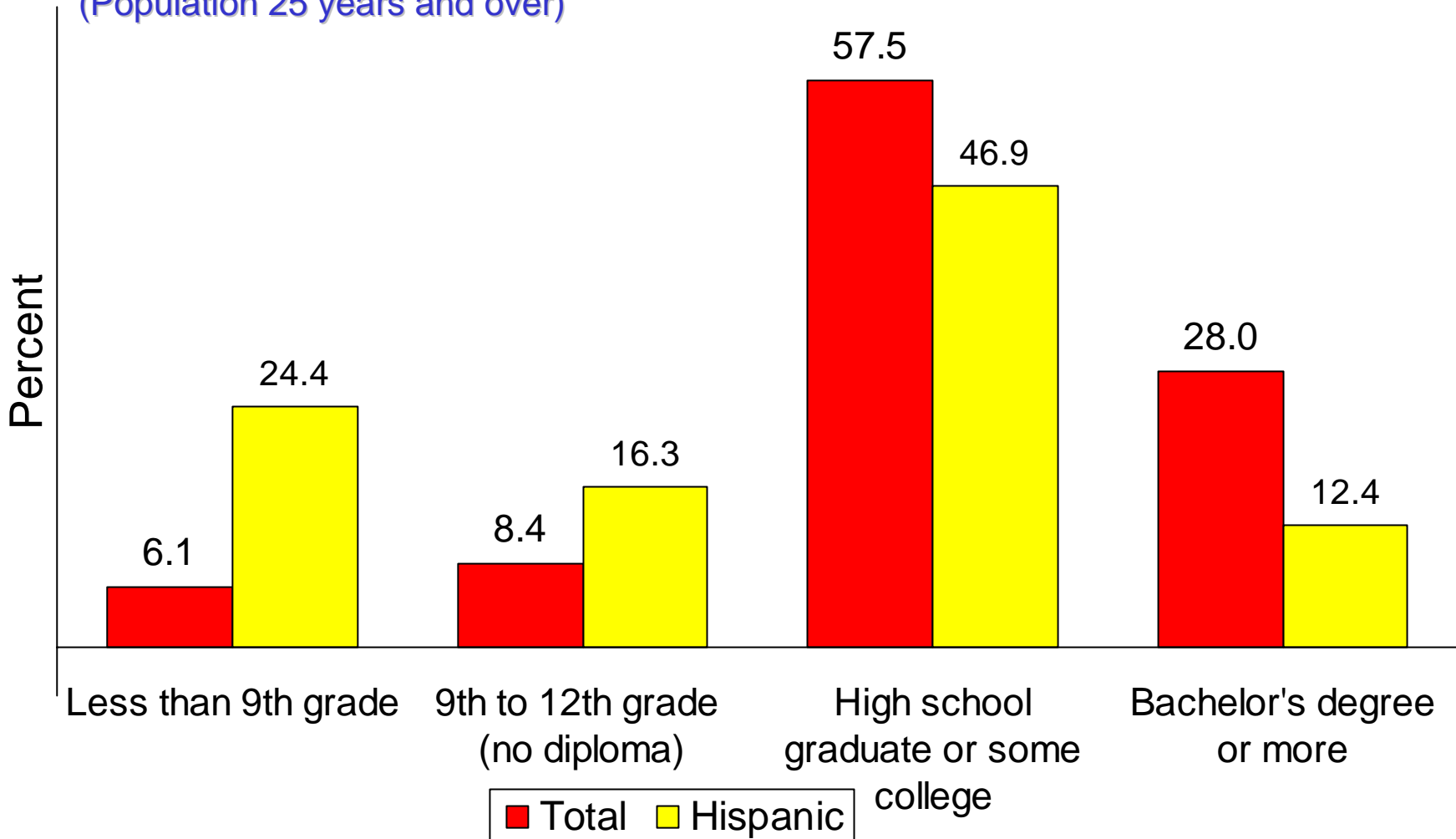

(Population 25 years and over)

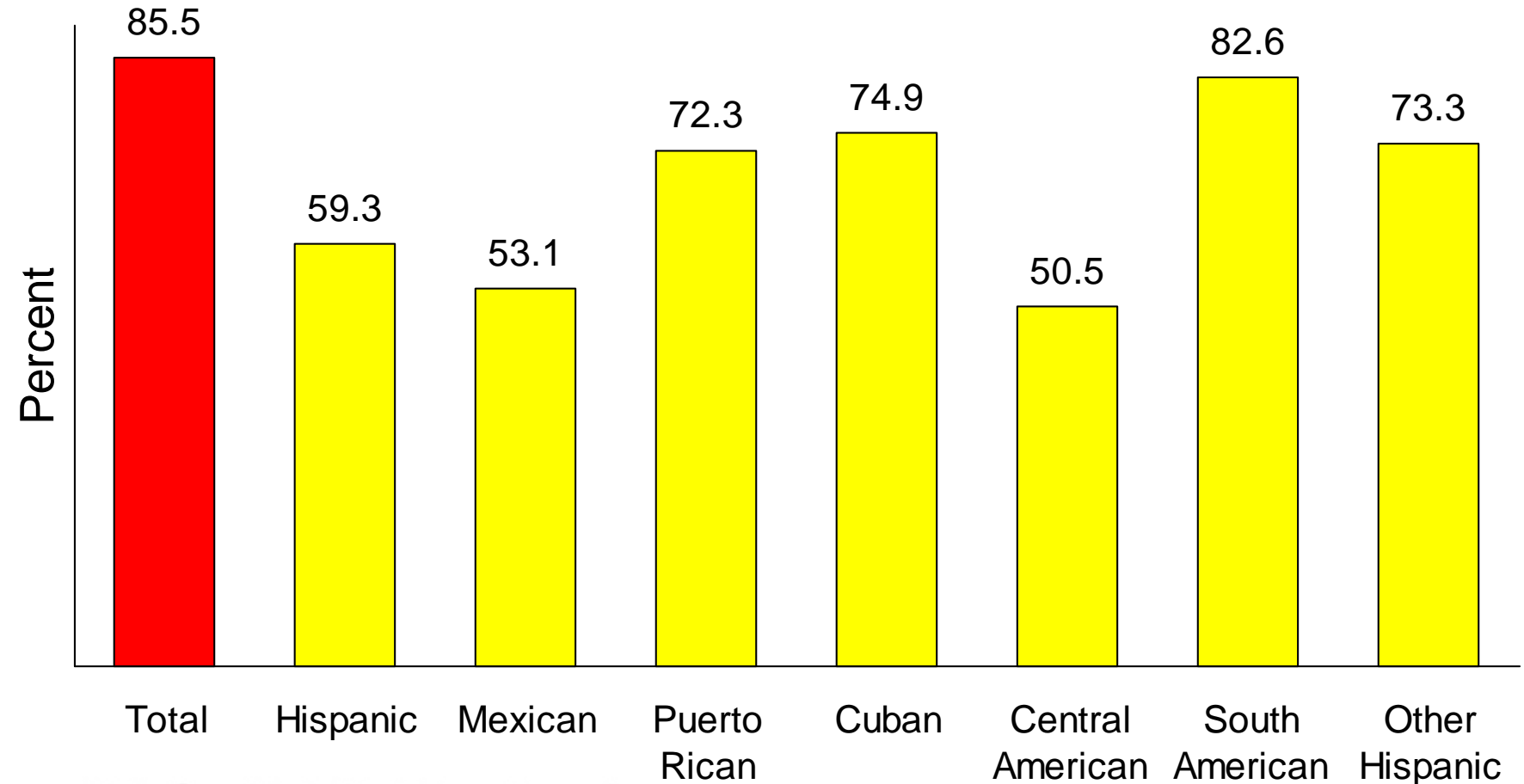

(Population 25 years and over)

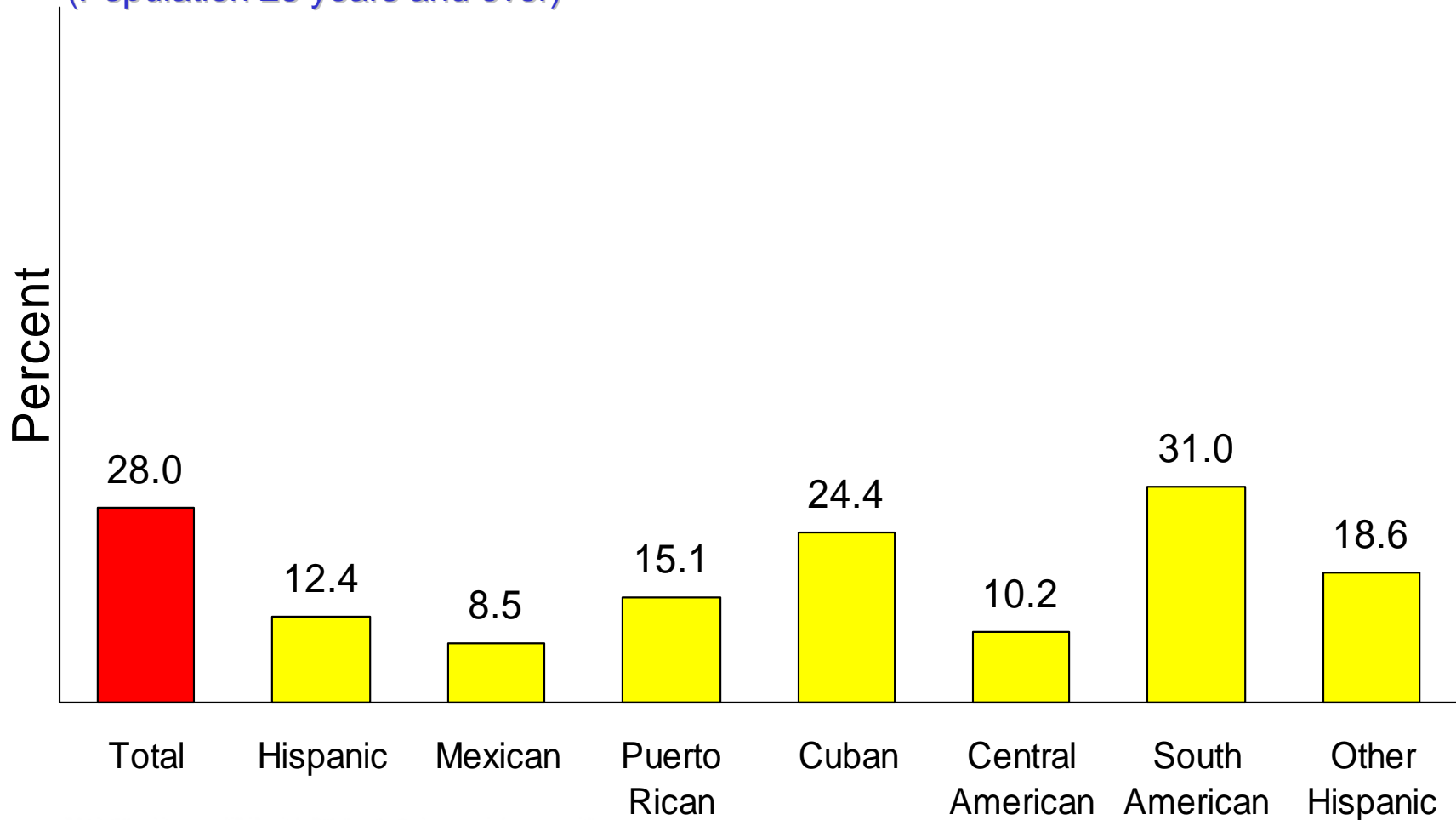

(Population 25 years and over)



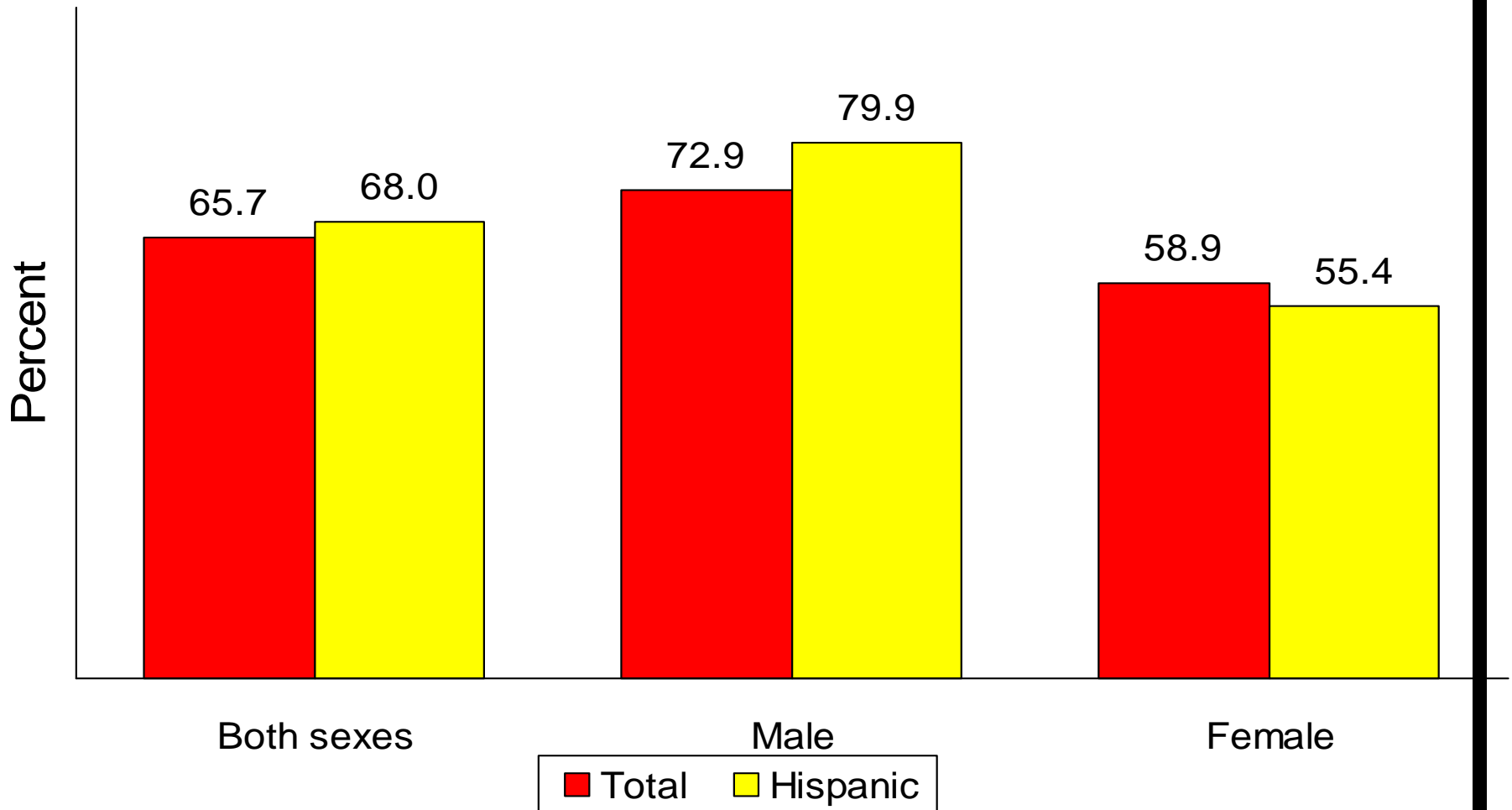

(Population 16 years and over in the civilian labor force)

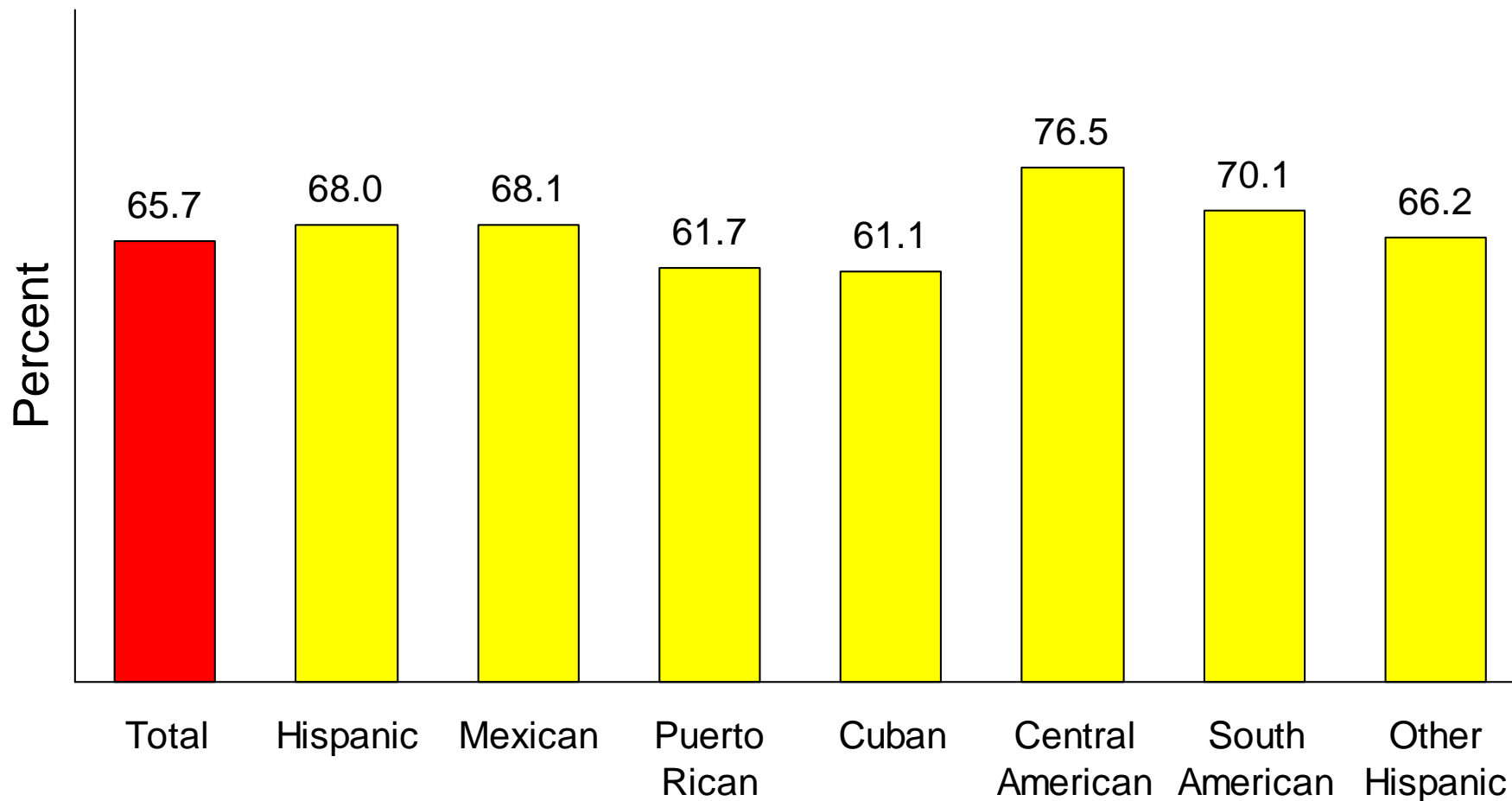

(Population 16 years and over in the civilian labor force)

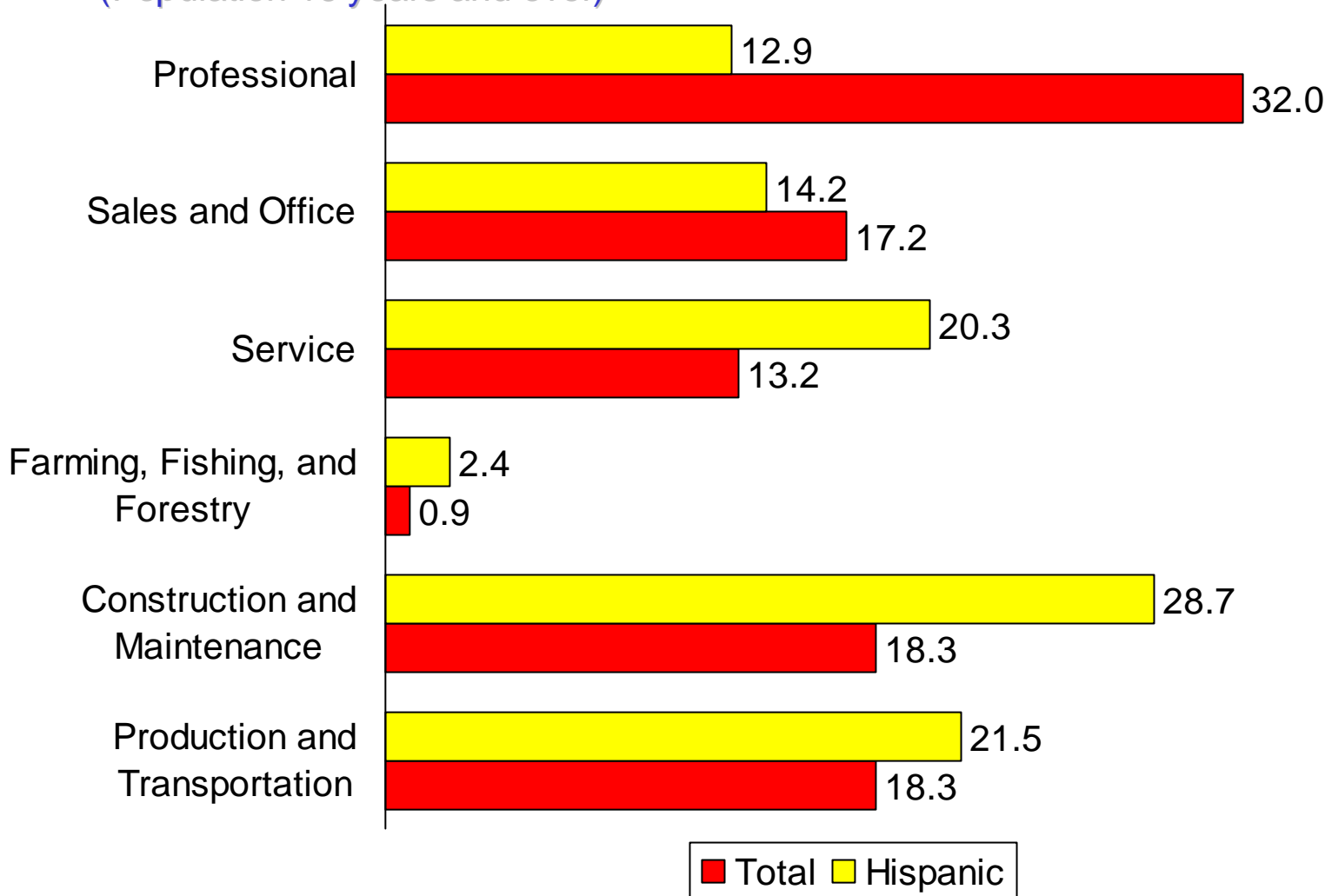

(Population 16 years and over)

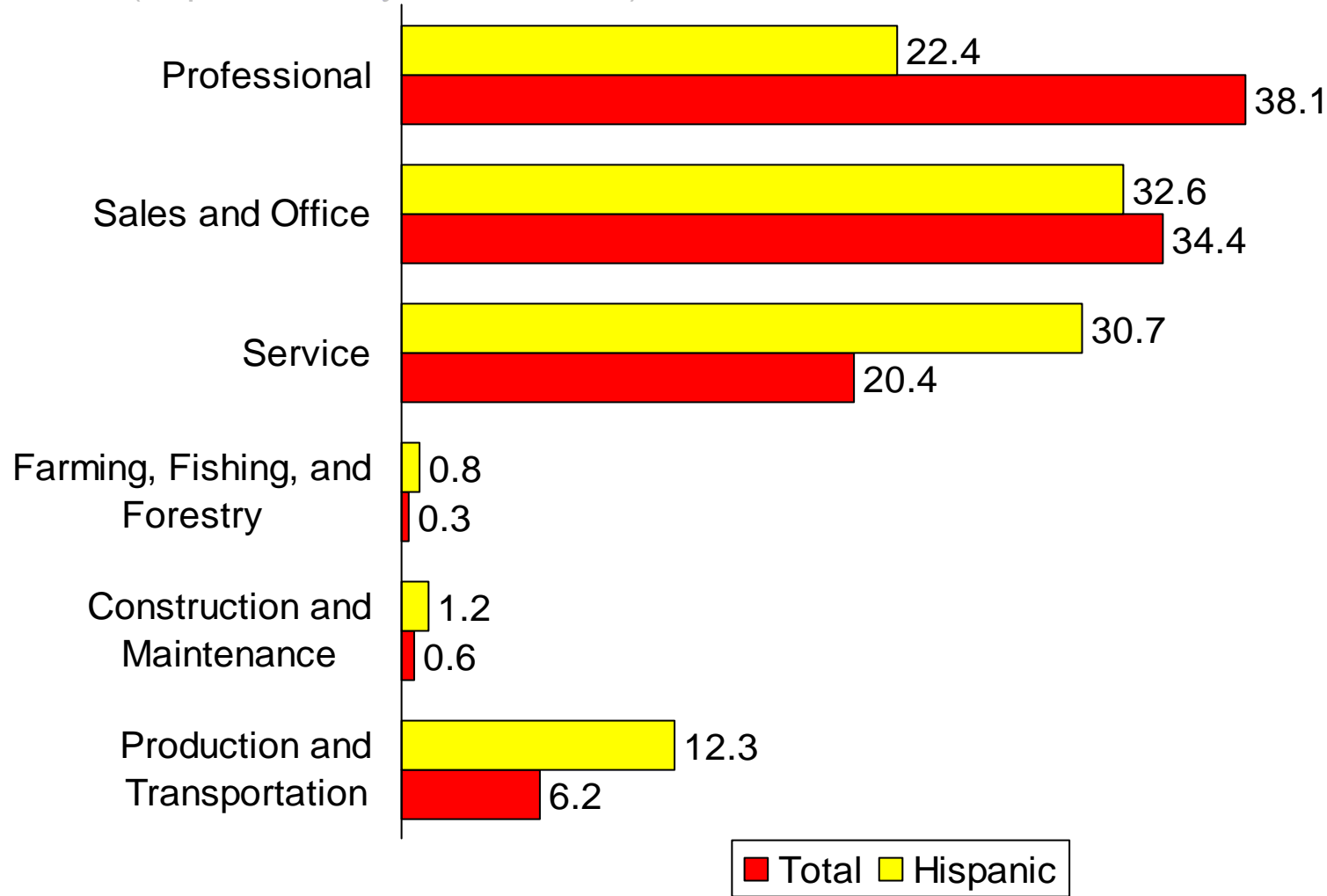

Percent Distribution of Females by Occupation and Hispanic Origin: 2006

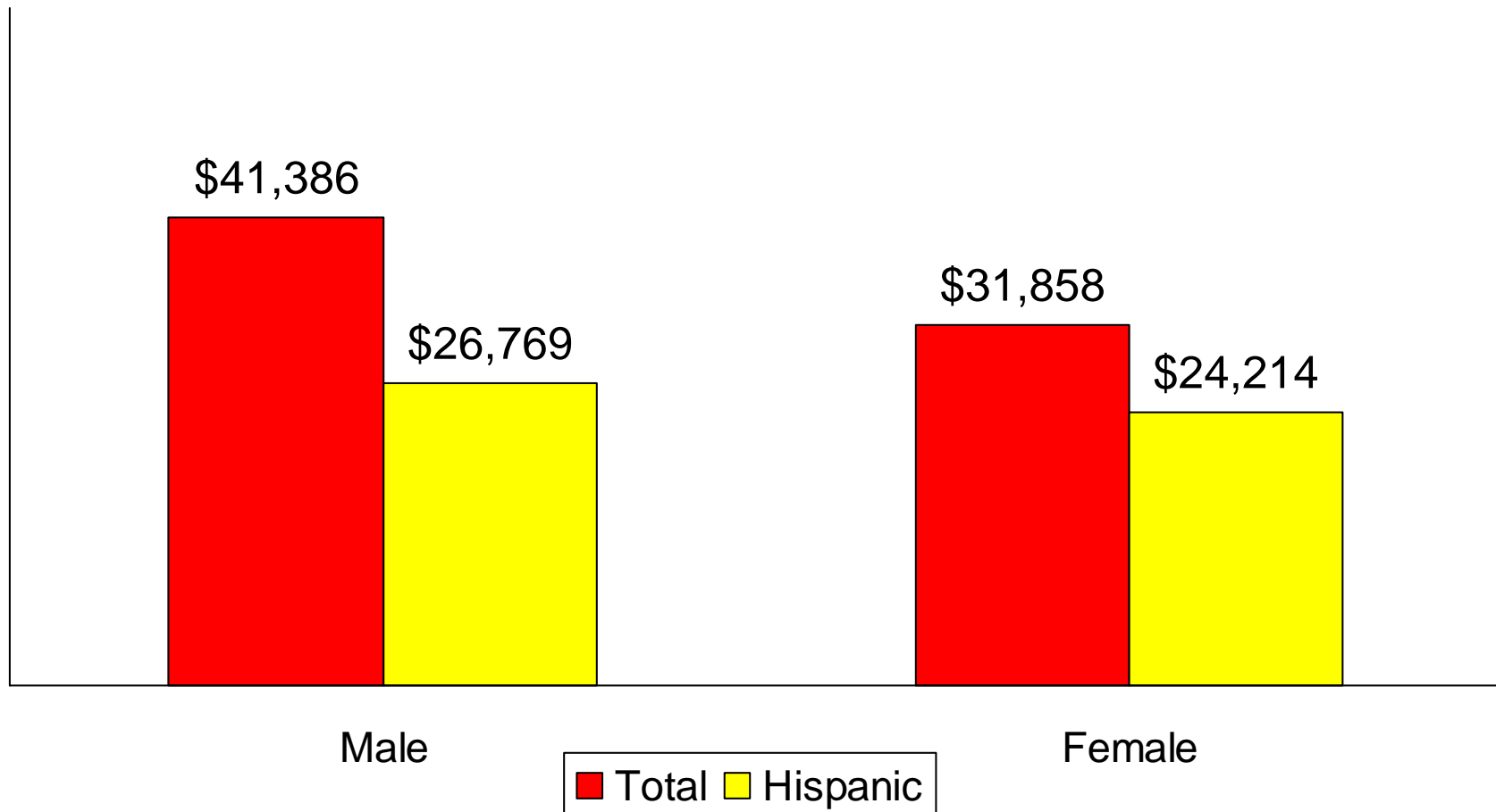

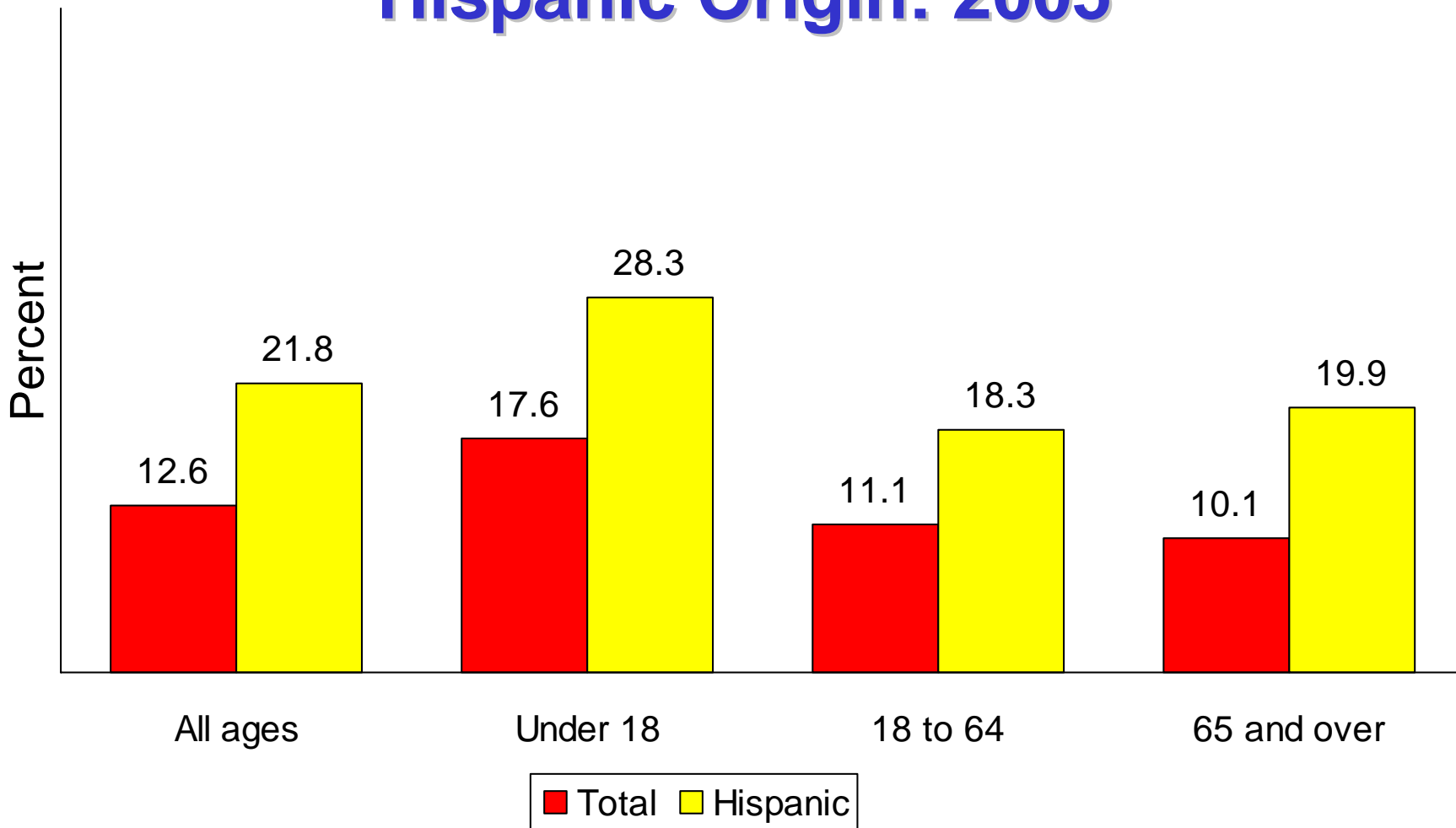
Median Earnings for Full-Time Year-Round Workers by Sex and Hispanic Origin: 2005

Percent of the Population Below the Poverty Level by Age and Hispanic Origin: 2005

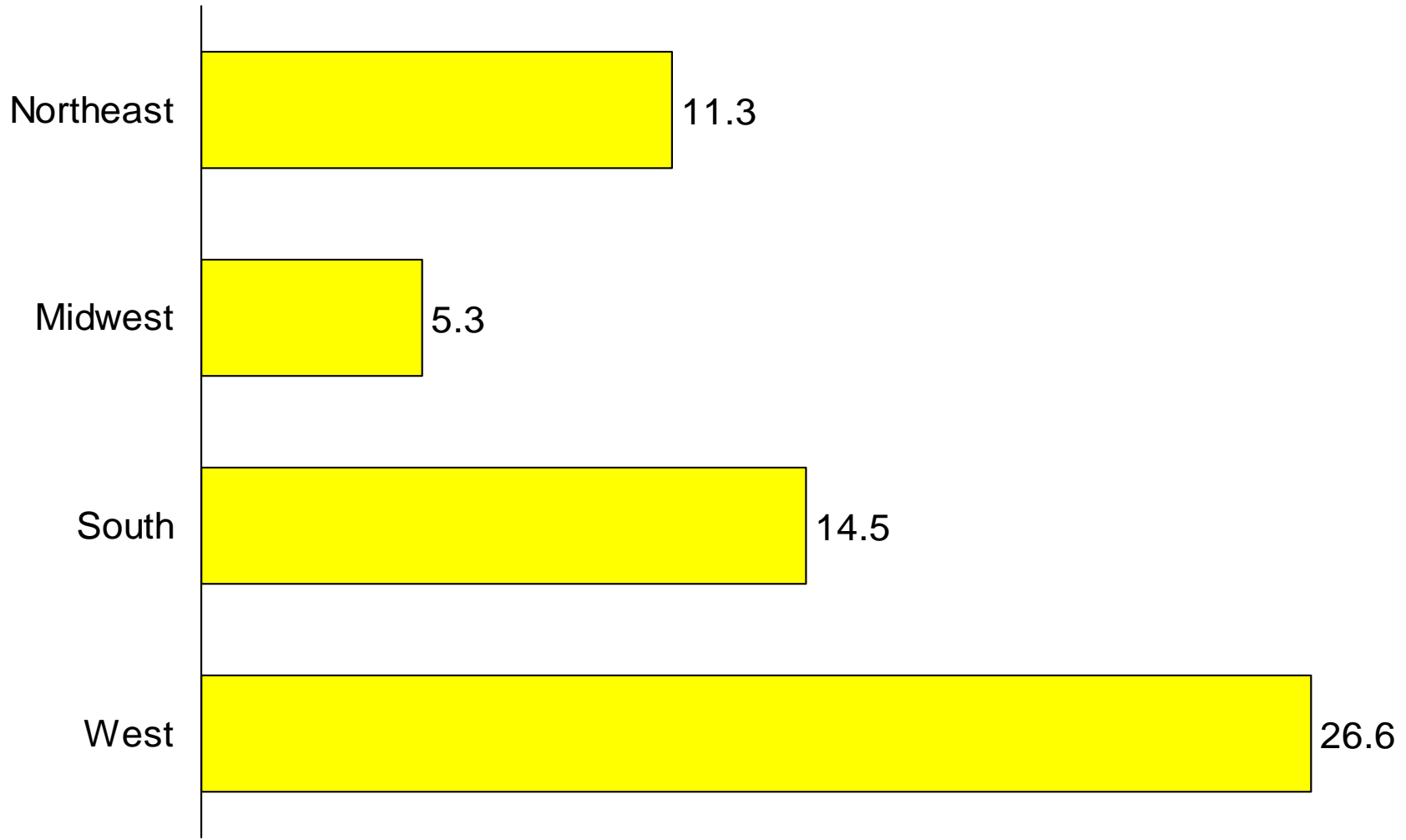
