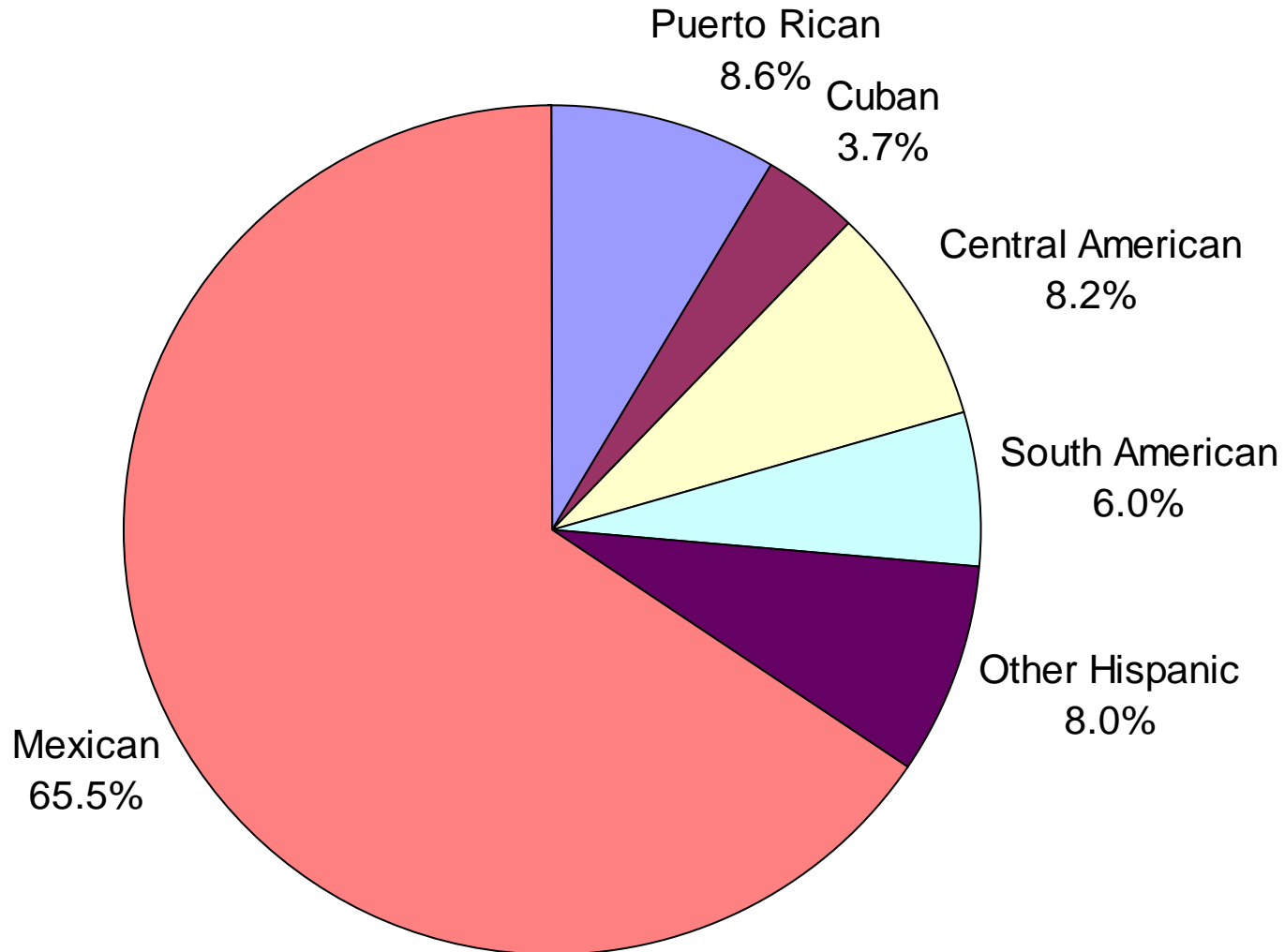

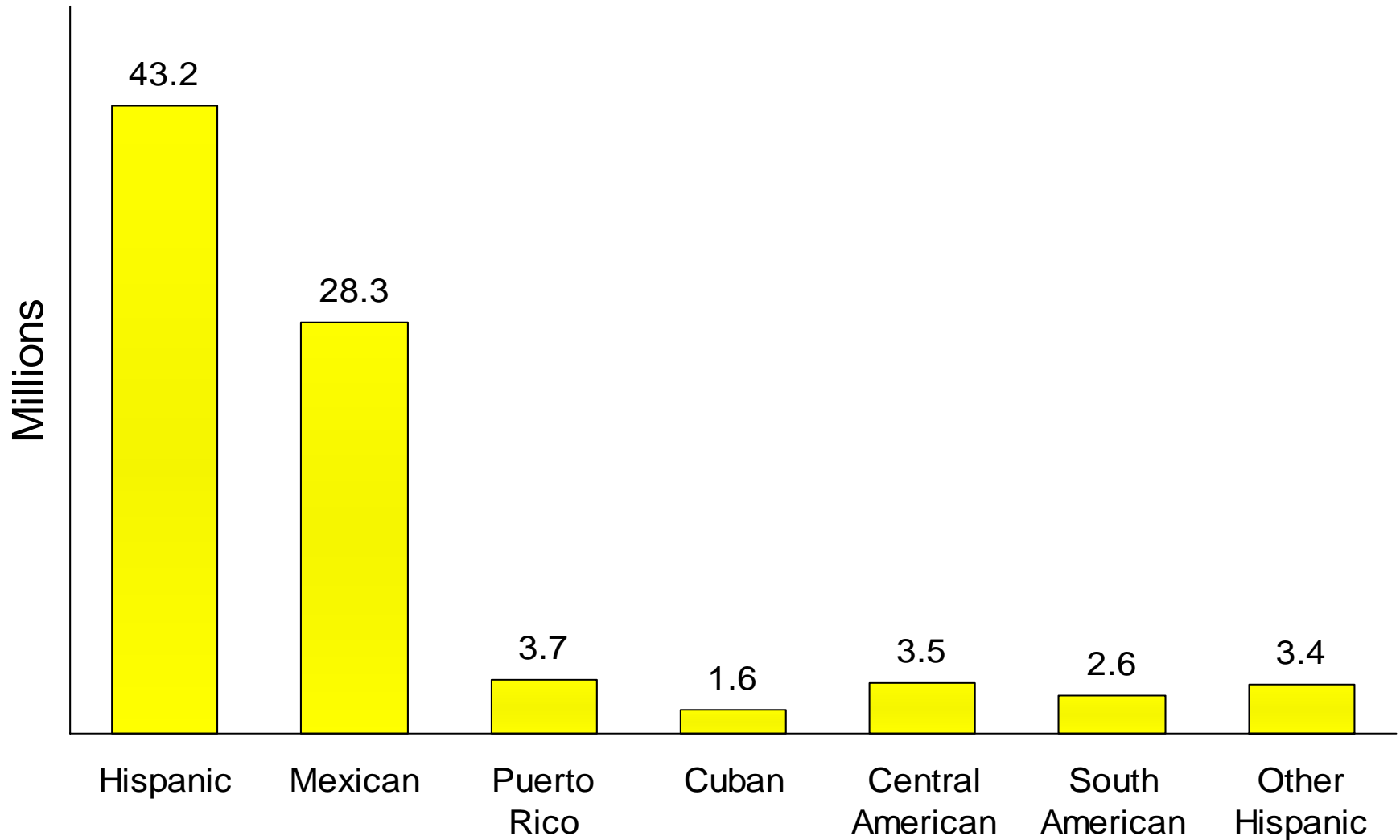
# Percent Distribution of Hispanics by Type: 2006

# Hispanic Population by Type: 2006

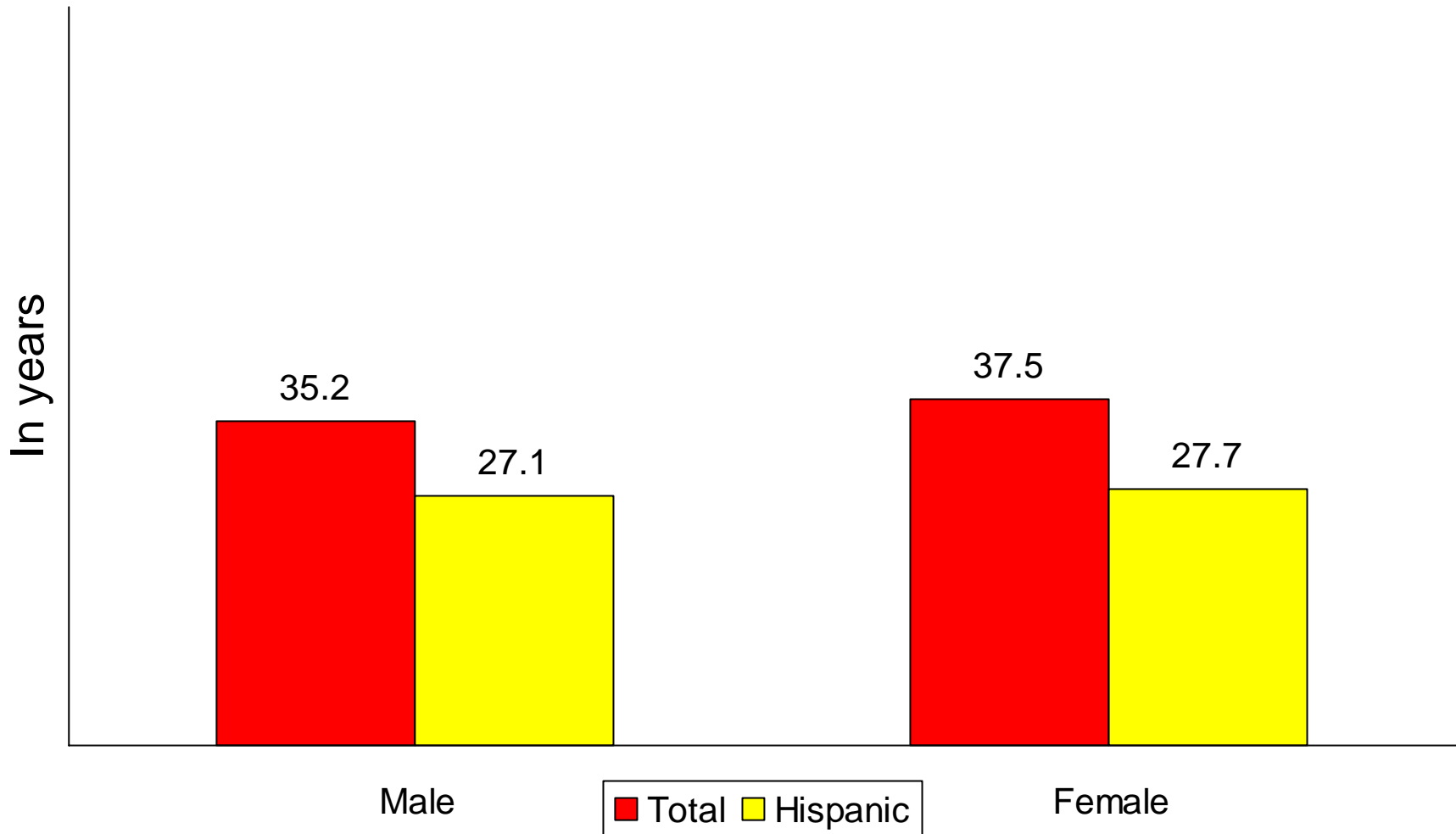

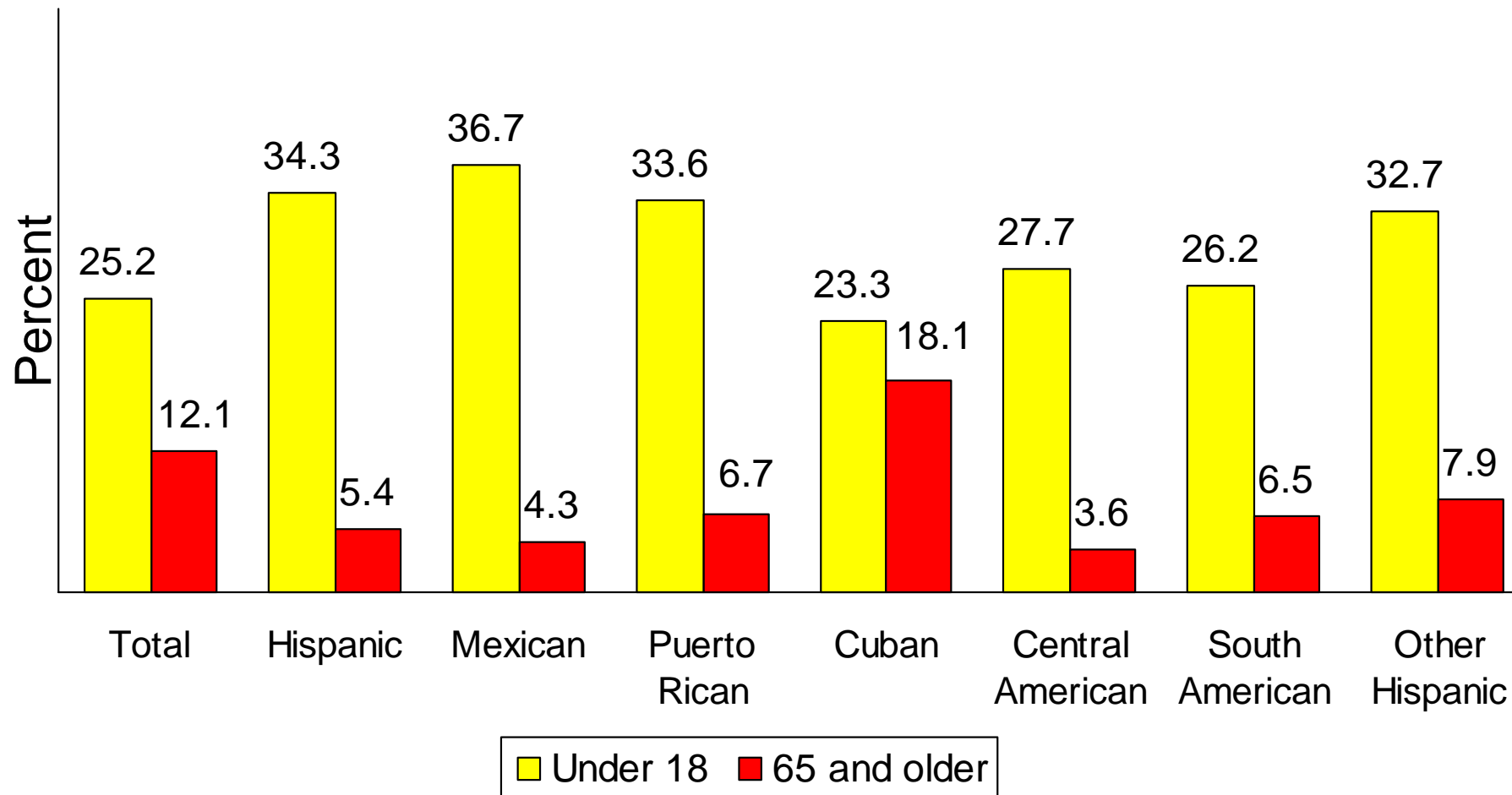

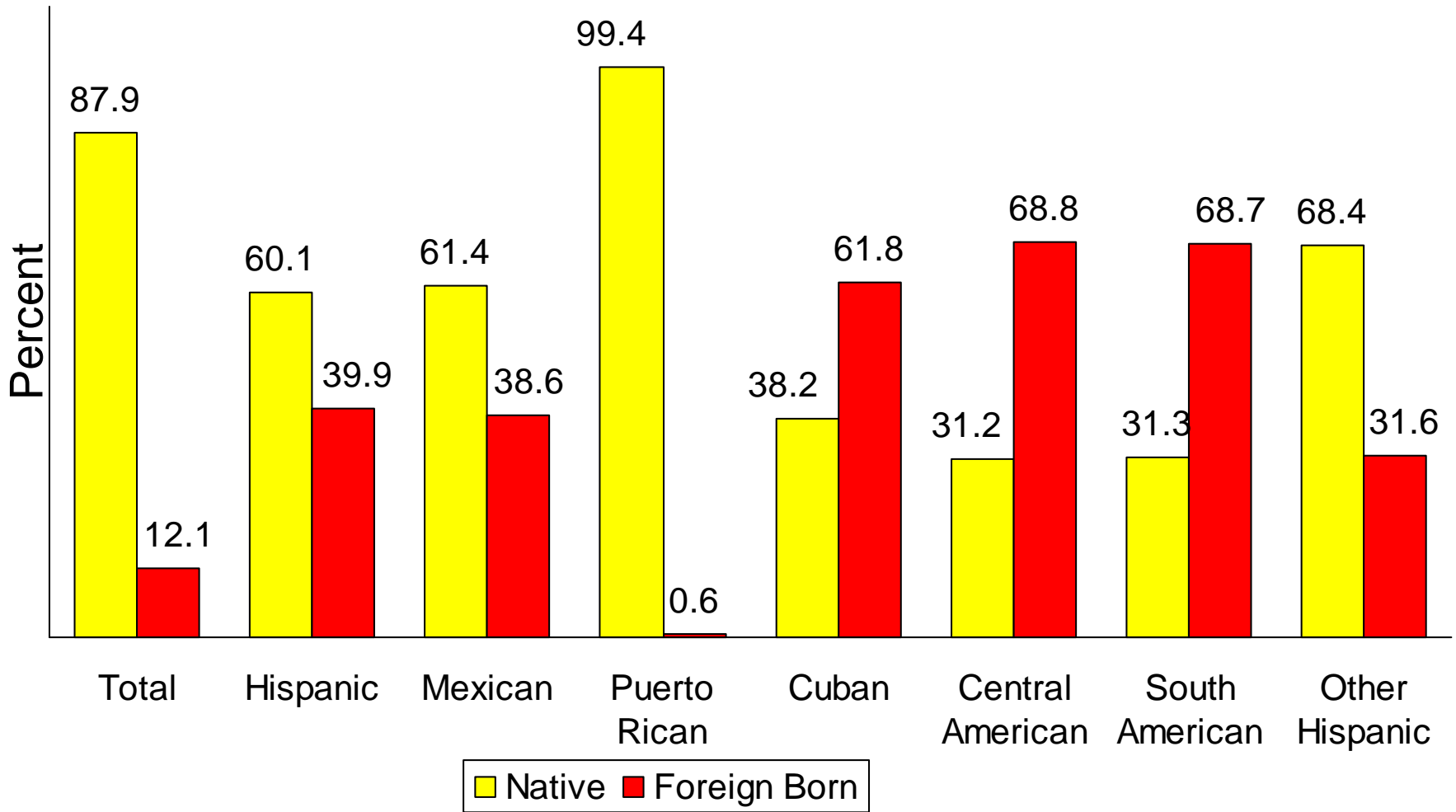
# Selected Age Groups by Type of Hispanic Origin: 2006

# Nativity by Type of Hispanic Origin: 2006



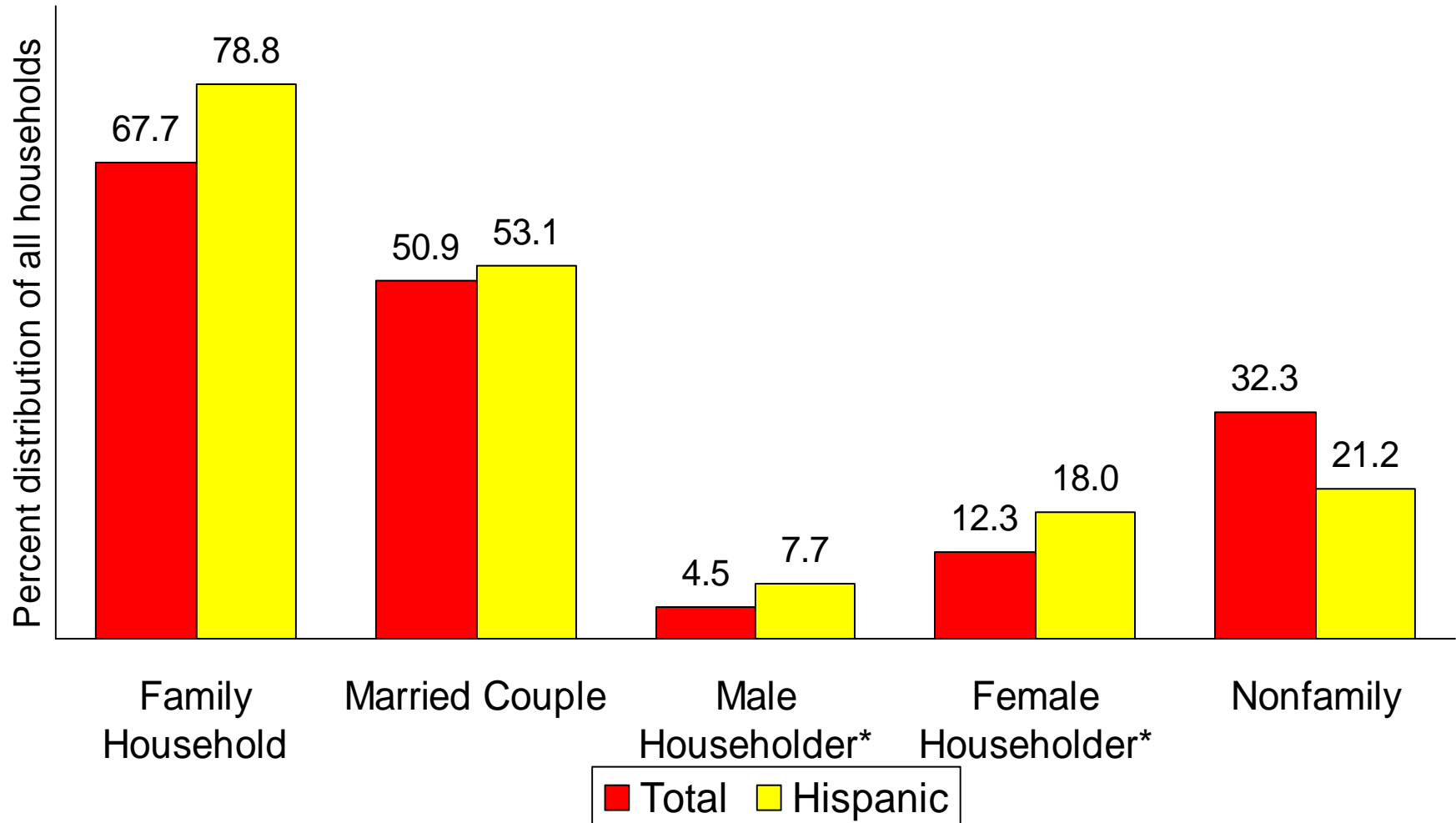

# Households by Type and Hispanic Origin: 2006



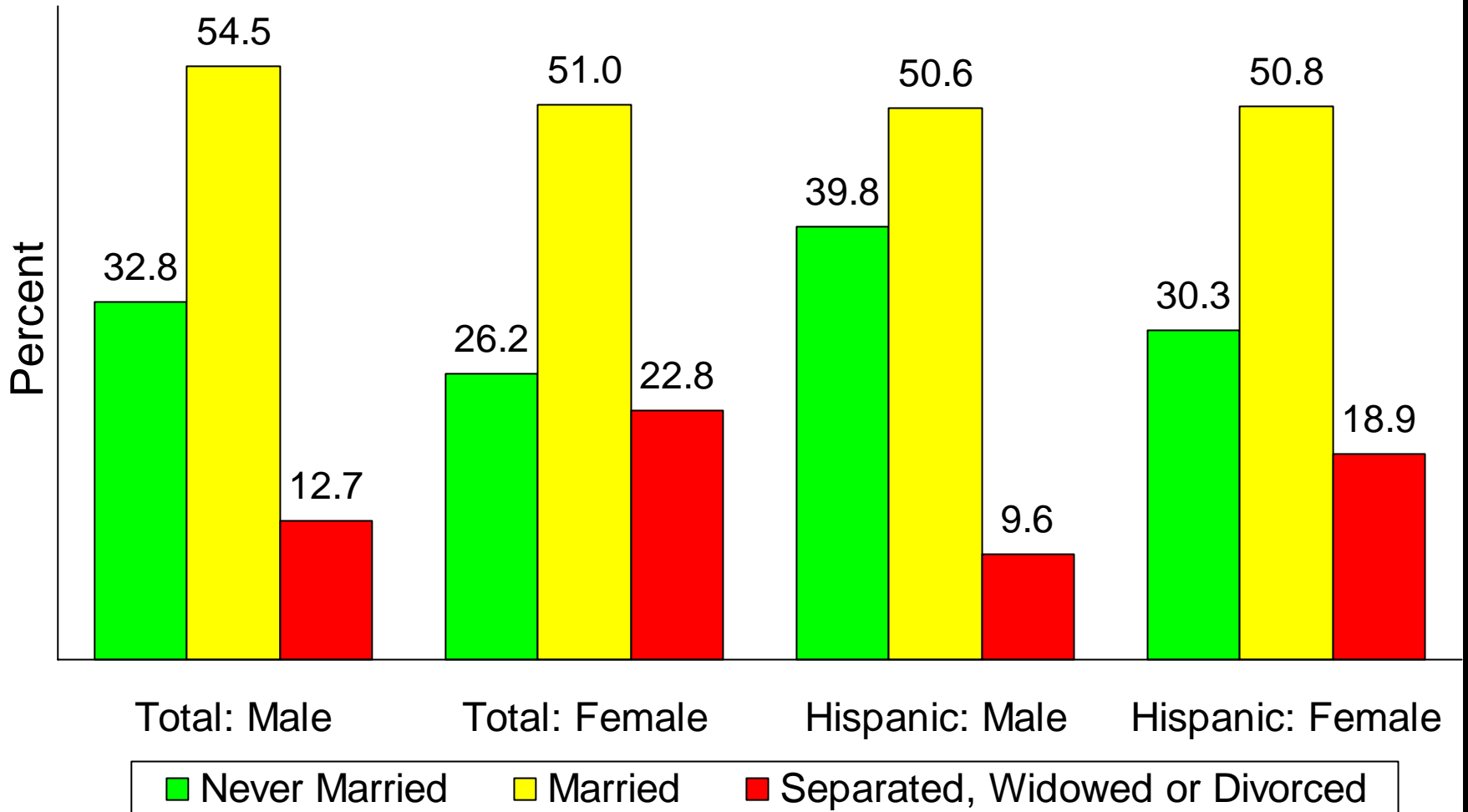

(Percent distribution of population 15 years and over)

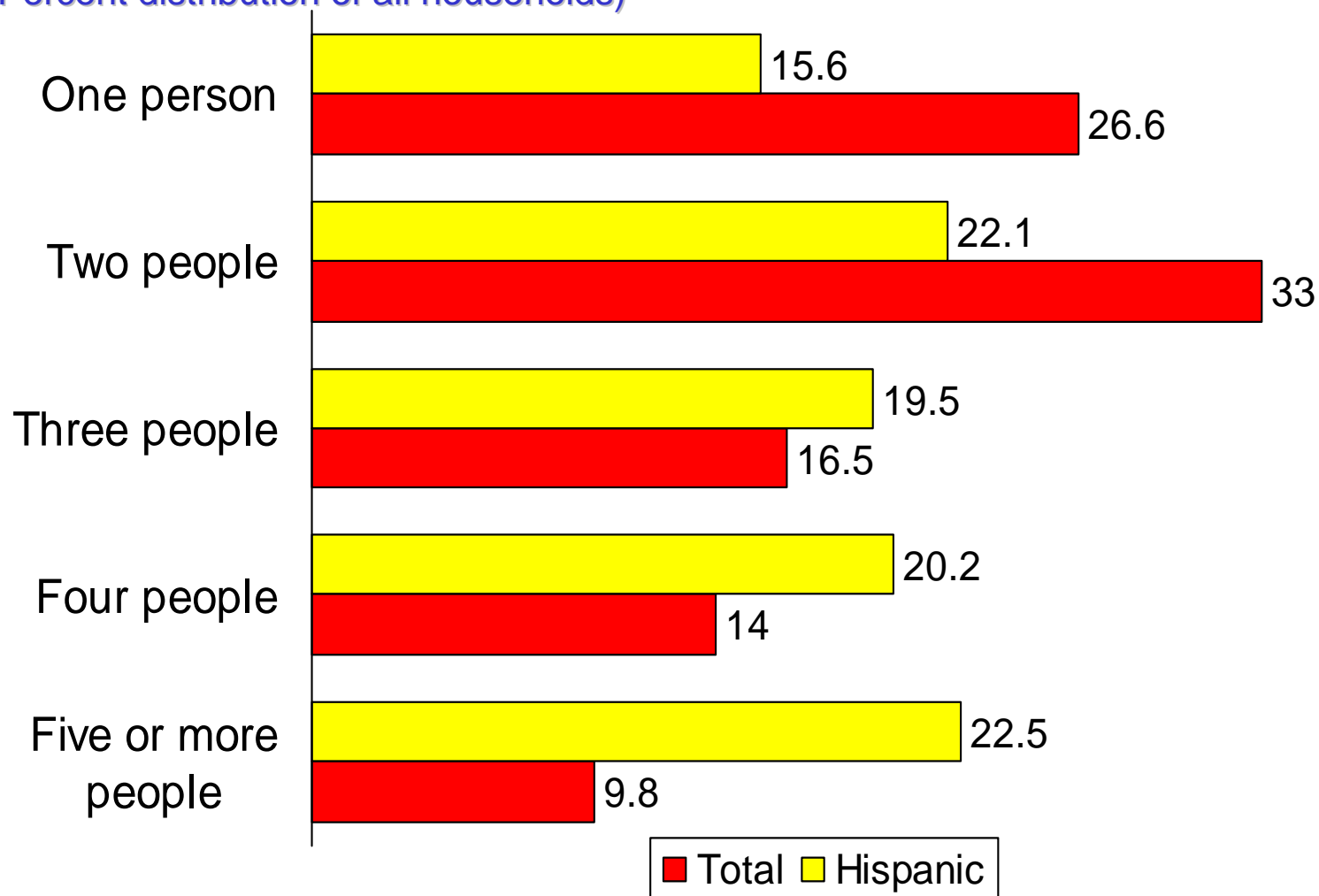

(Percent distribution of all households)



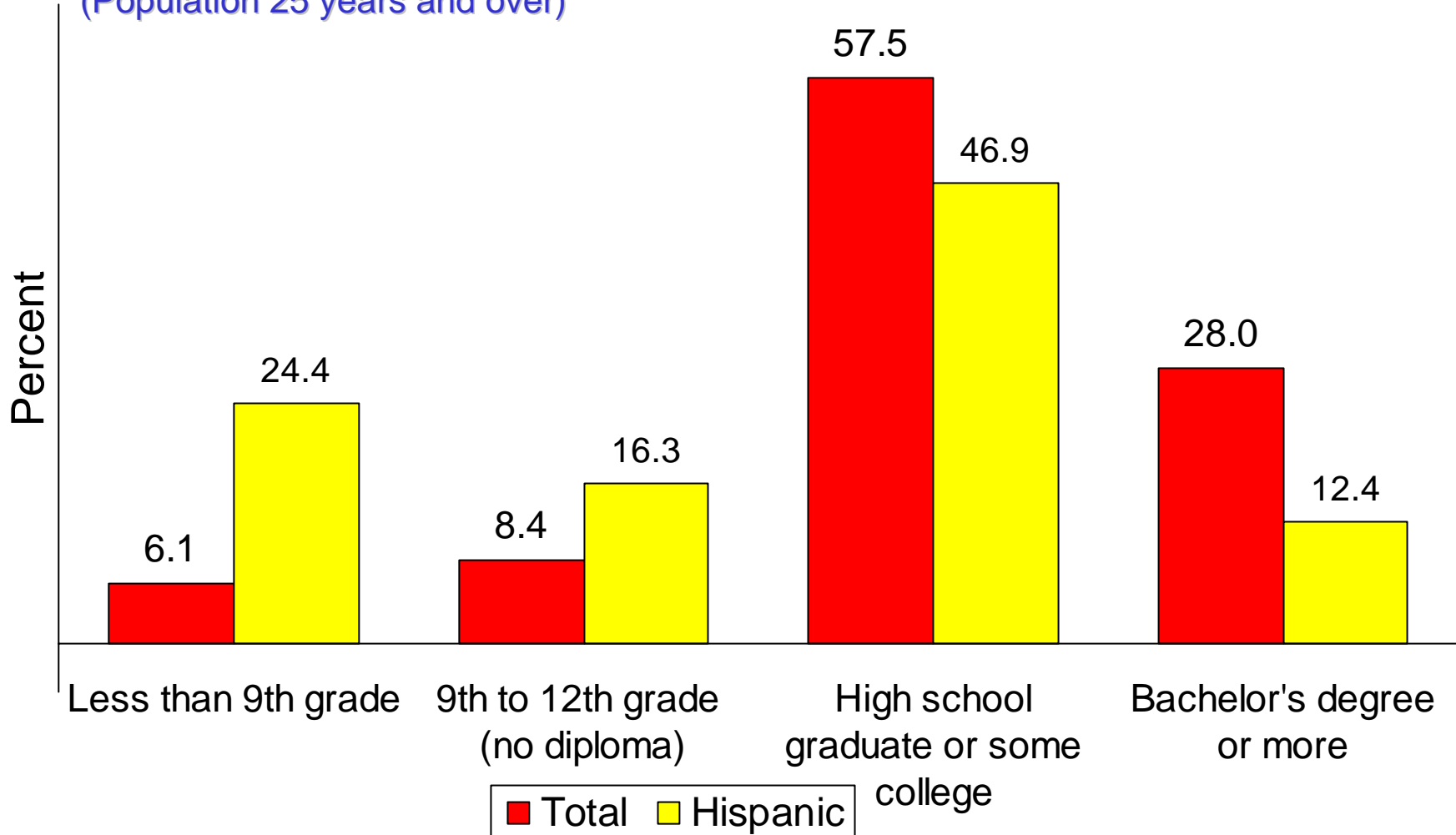

(Population 25 years and over)

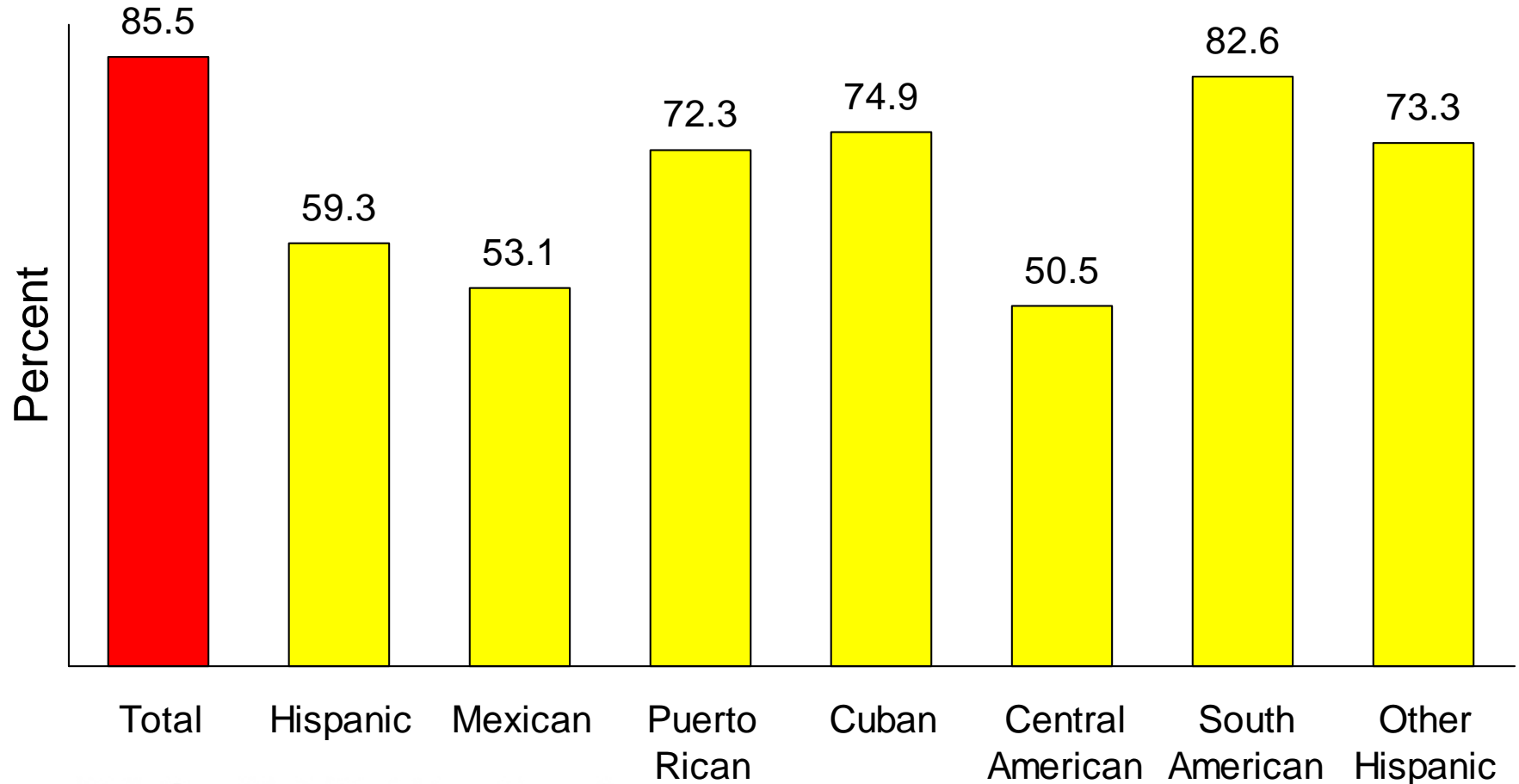

(Population 25 years and over)

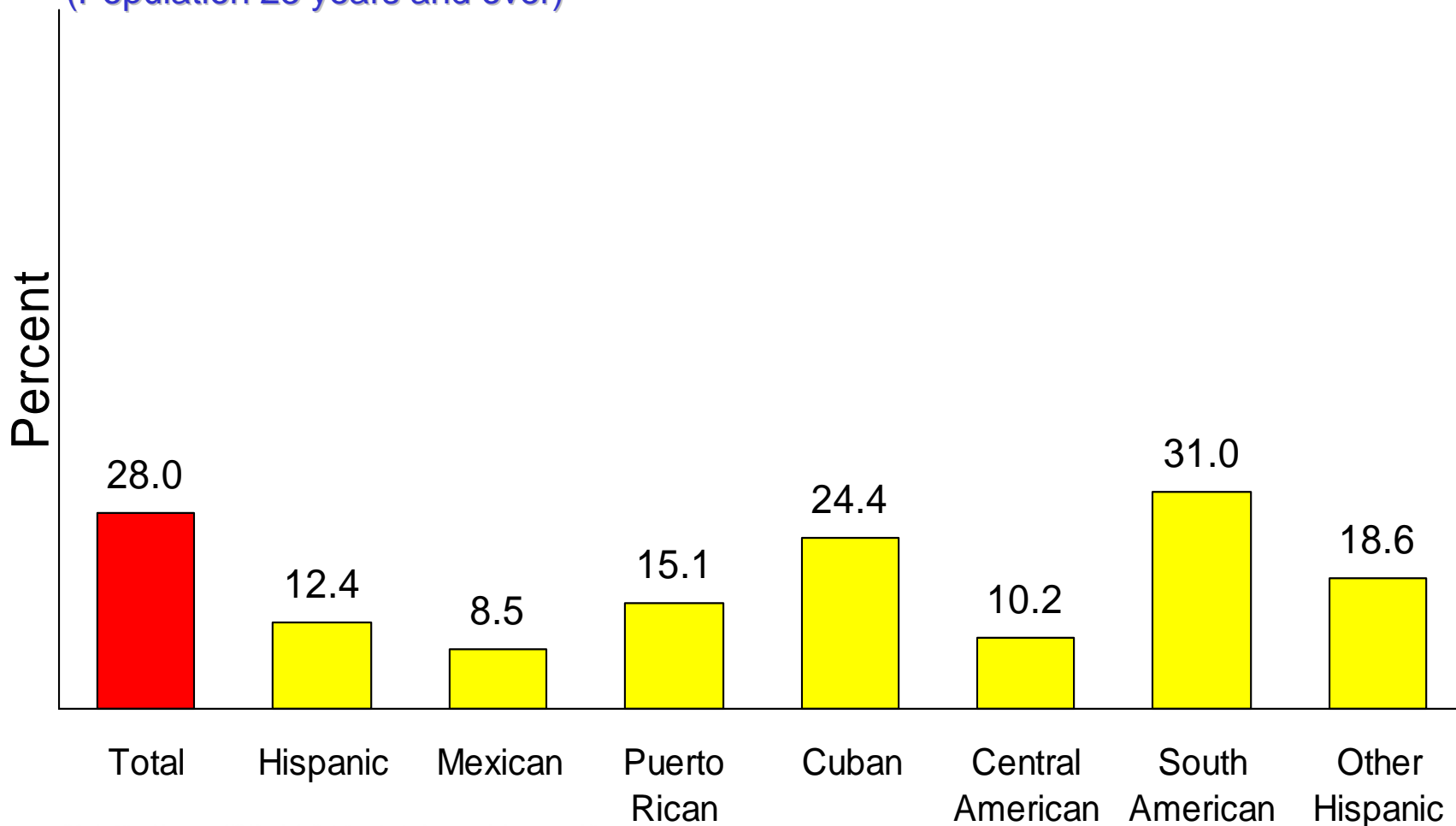

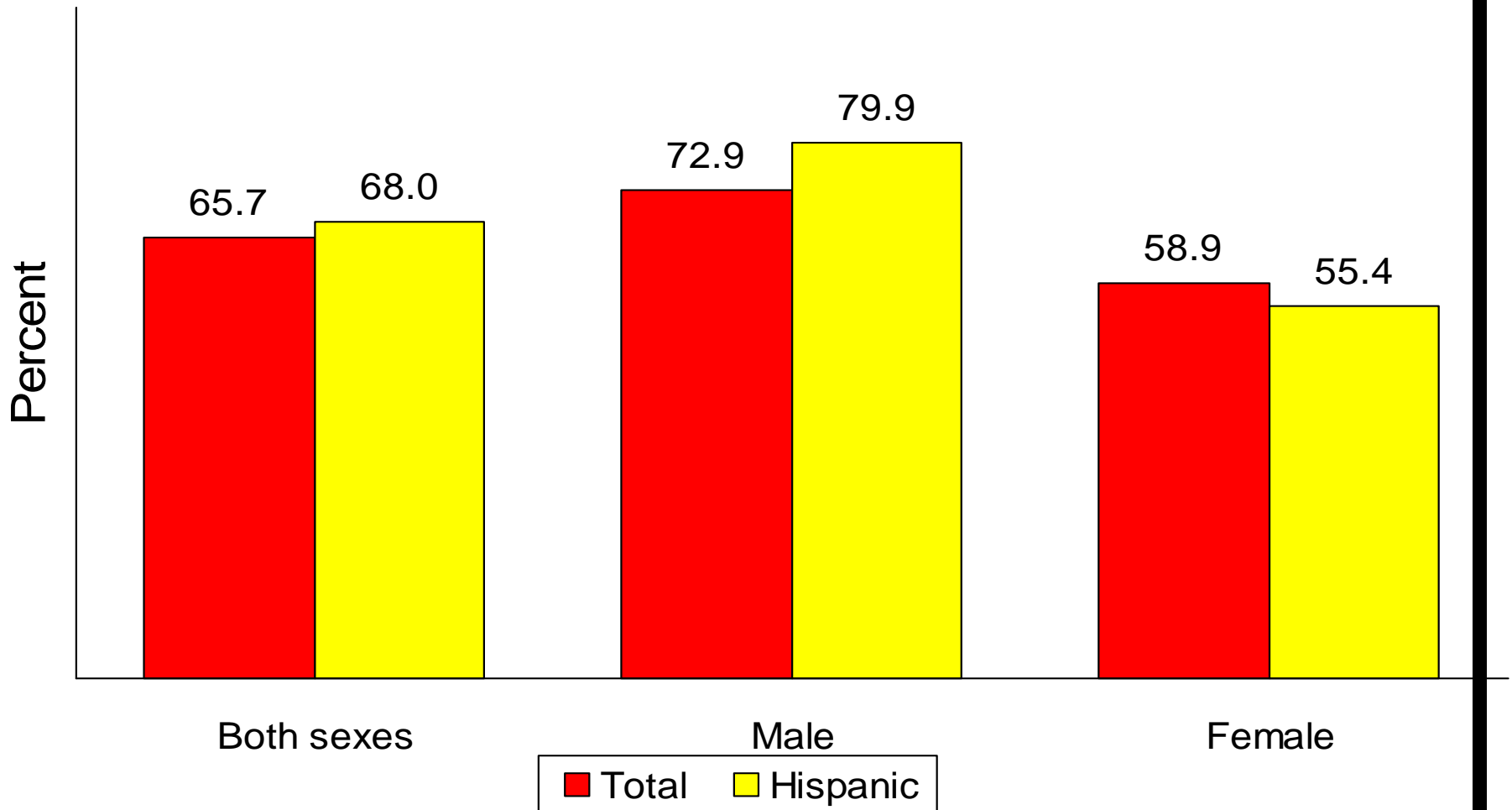

(Population 16 years and over in the civilian labor force)

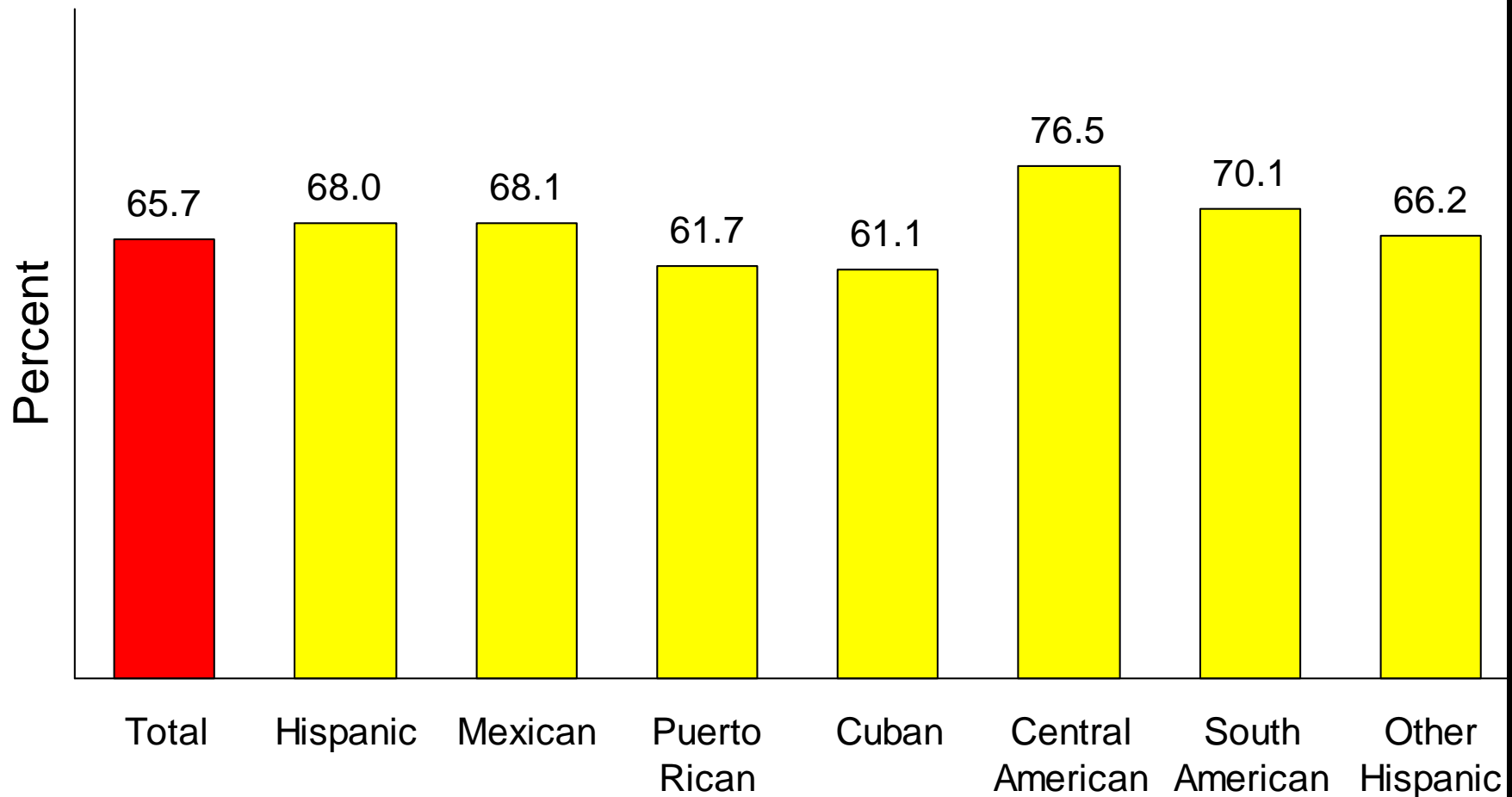

(Population 16 years and over in the civilian labor force)

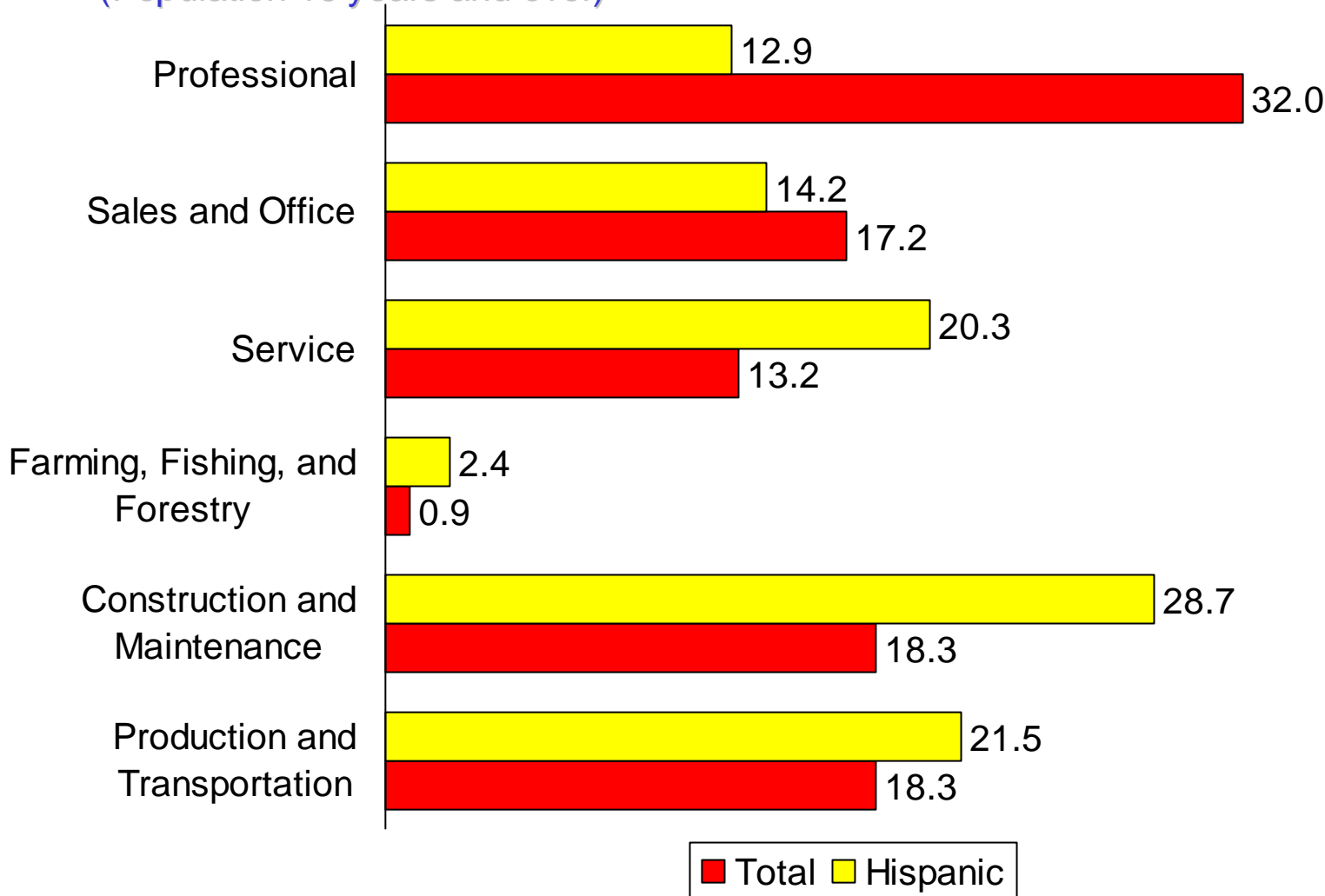

(Population 16 years and over)

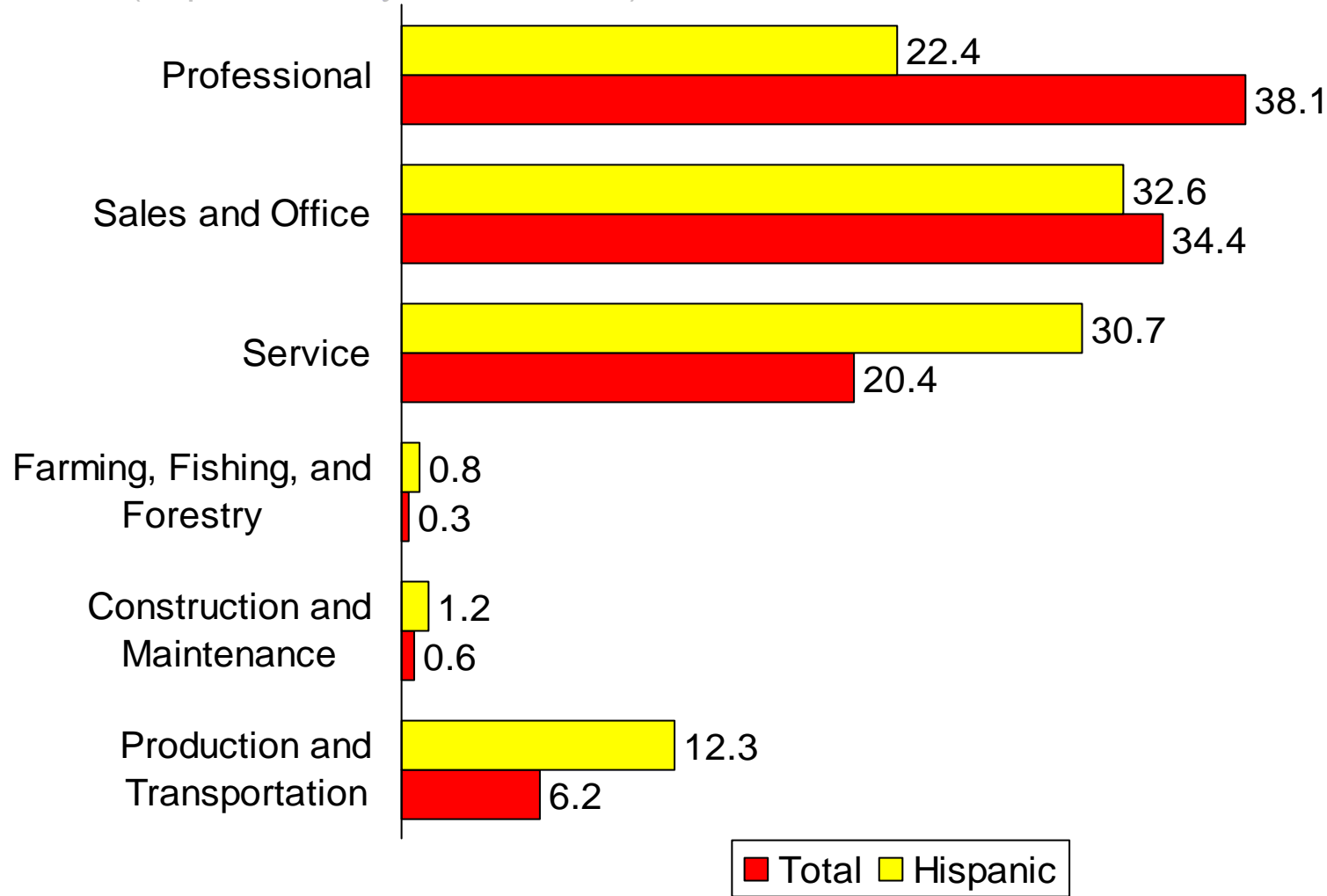

# Percent Distribution of Females by Occupation and Hispanic Origin: 2006

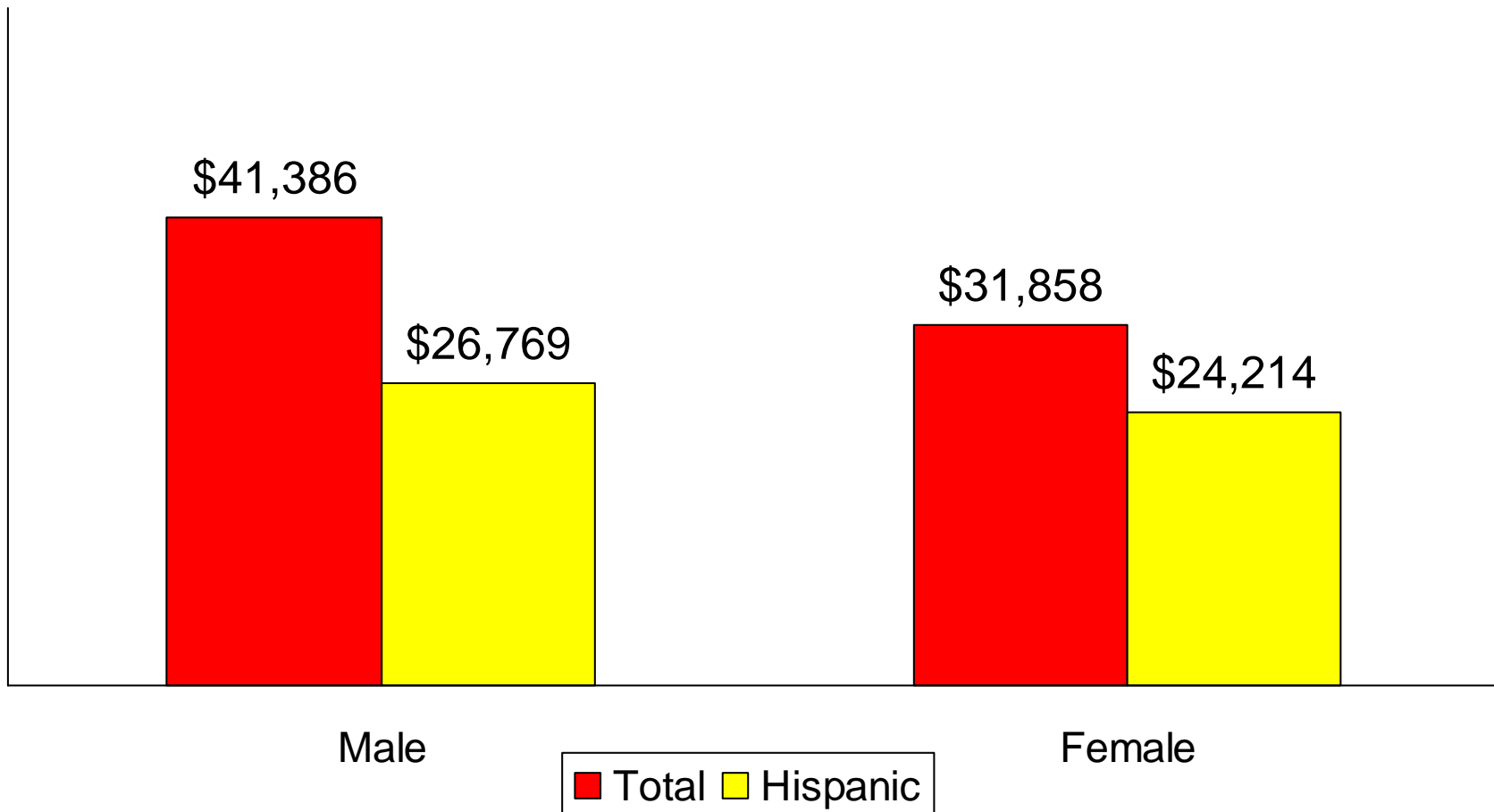

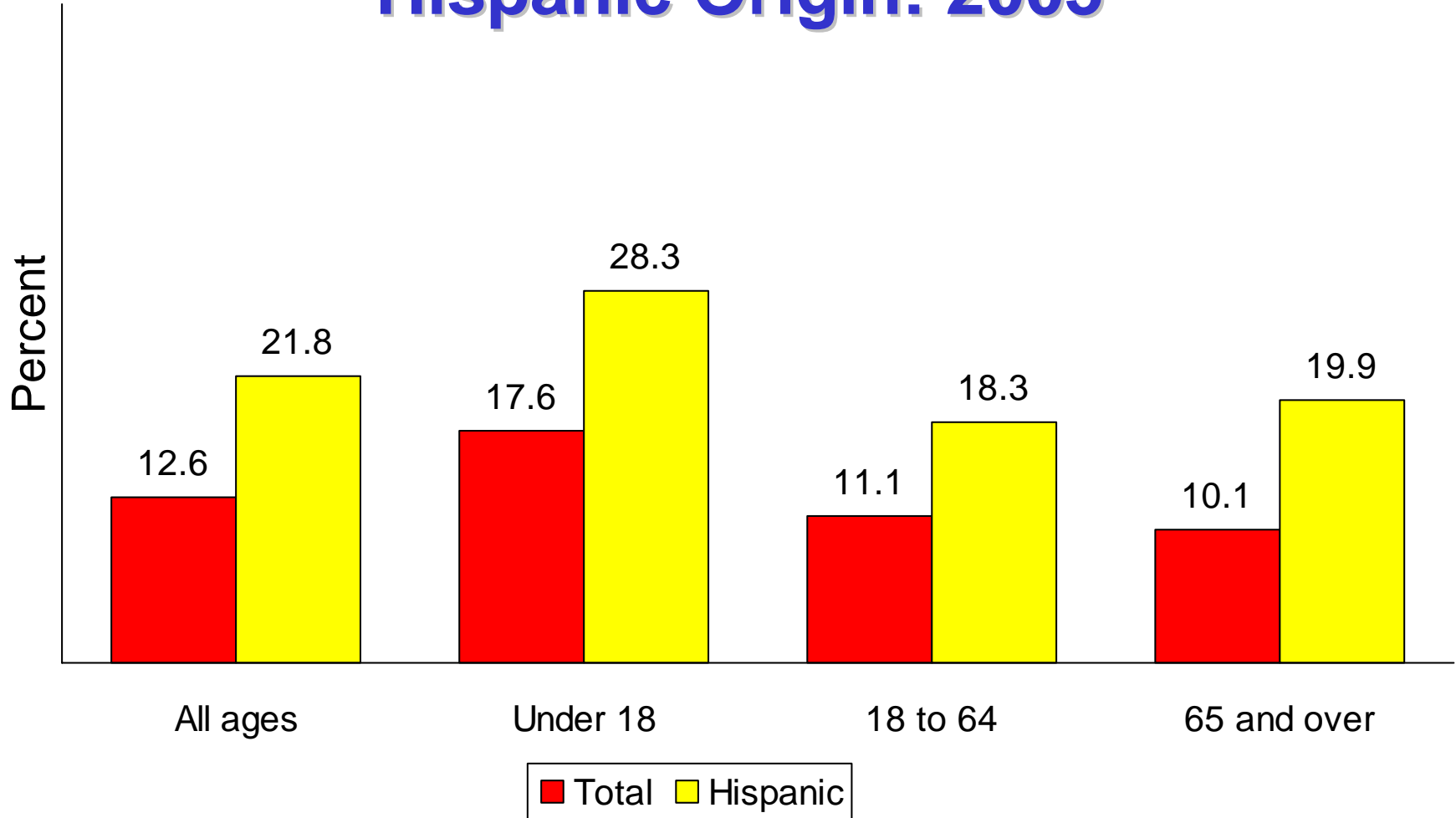
# Median Earnings for Full-Time Year-Round Workers by Sex and Hispanic Origin: 2005

# Percent of the Population Below the Poverty Level by Age and Hispanic Origin: 2005



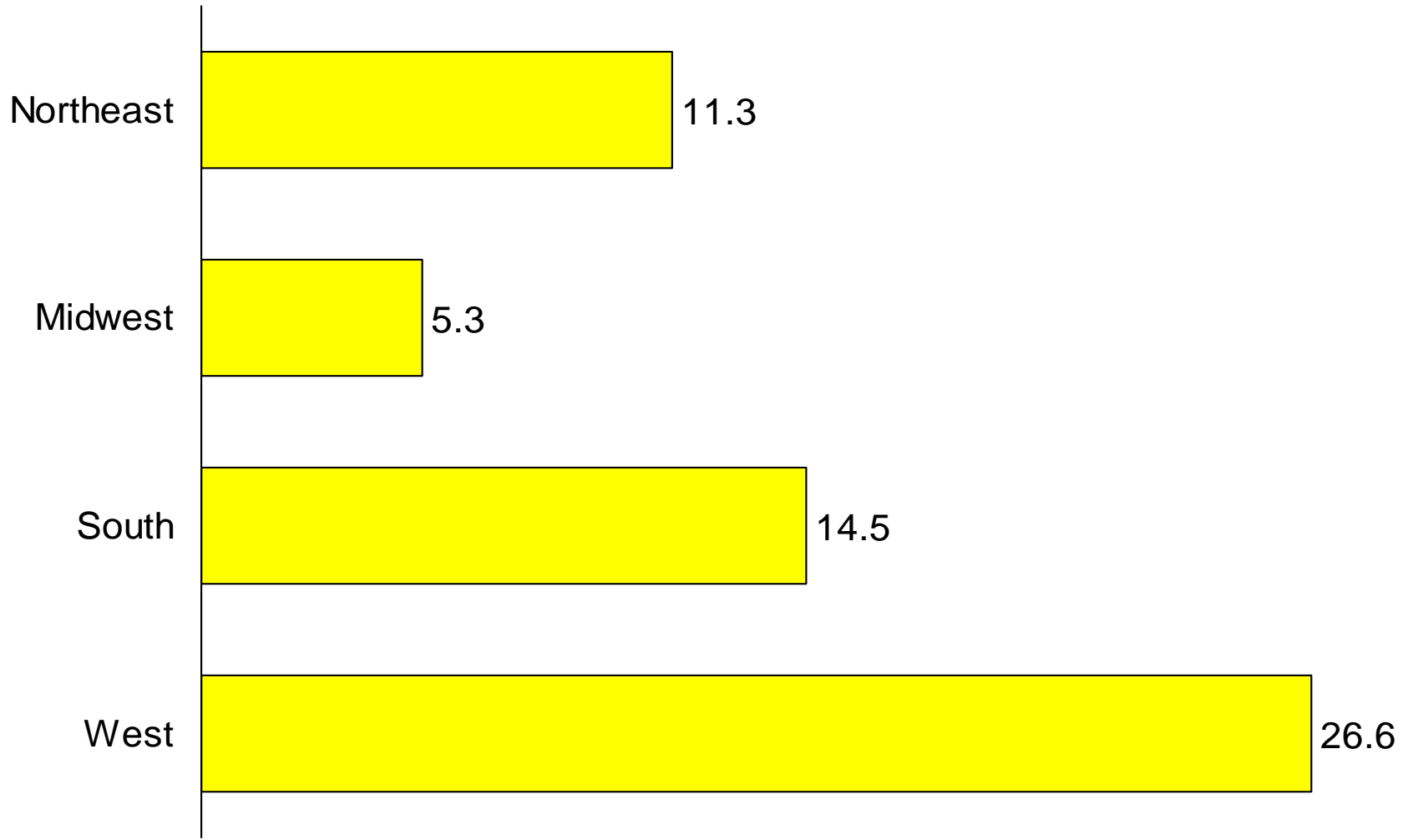
