




#### Veterans: 1980 to 2010





## Period of Military Service: 2000 and 2010






#### Percentage Veteran by State: 2010








#### Women Veterans: 1980 to 2010




#### Women Veterans by Age: 2010



### Age by Veteran Status: 2010




## Age 65 Years and Over by Veteran Status: 2000 to 2010

## Race and Hispanic Origin for Veterans: 1990 to 2010






## Race and Hispanic Origin by Age for Veterans: 2010


















# Service-Connected Disability by Age for Veterans: 2010






## Disability Status by Age: 2010




