Figure 1. Percent where reported sex is inconsistent with Social Security record







Figure 2. Relationship question: 2010 and revised versions

Figure 4. Distributions of Relationship do not differ between test and control






Figure 5. Relationship Question: 2016 Census Test





Figure 6. Percent of Cases Reported as Nonrelatives, by Treatment Type: 2016 Census Test

Figure 7. Percent of Cases with Inconsistent Relationship and Sex Reports, by Mode







Figure 8. Percent of Cases with Inconsistent Relationship and Sex Reports, by Mode

Figure 9. Image of Relationship Confirmation Question






Figure 10. Image of Sex Confirmation Question






Figure 11. 2016 ACS Content Test Automated Check Screenshots




Figure 12. 2016 ACS Content Test Automated Check Screenshots




Figure 13. 2016 ACS Content Test Automated Check Screenshots




Figure 14. 2016 ACS Content Test Automated Check Screenshots




Figure 15. Percent of Cases with Inconsistent Relationship and Sex Reports, by Mode






Figure 16. Image of Sex/Rel Automated Edit: 2016 CT





Figure 17. What Respondents Changed in the Automated Check: 2015 NCT
