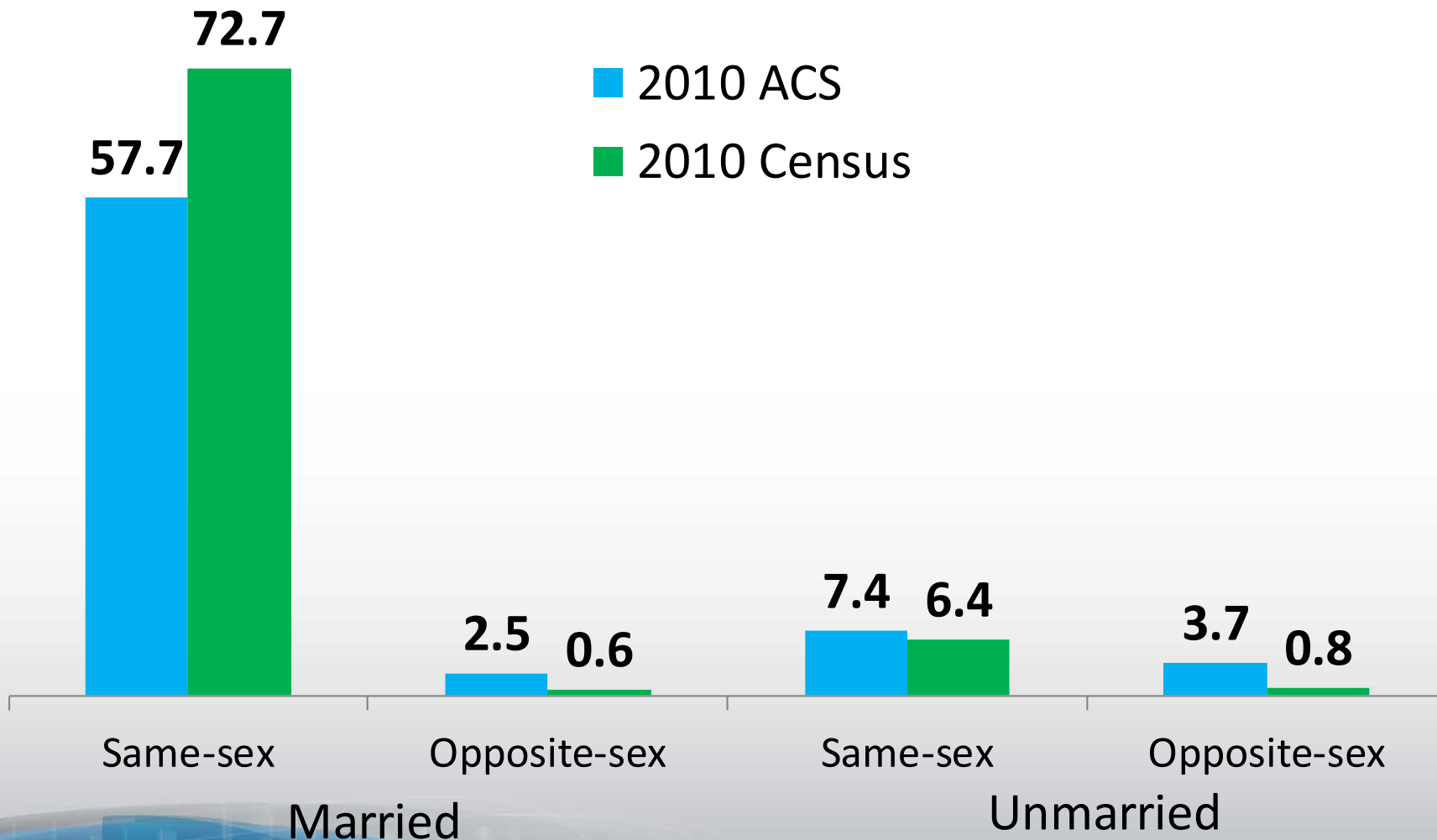


# Figure 1. Percent where reported sex is inconsistent with Social Security record

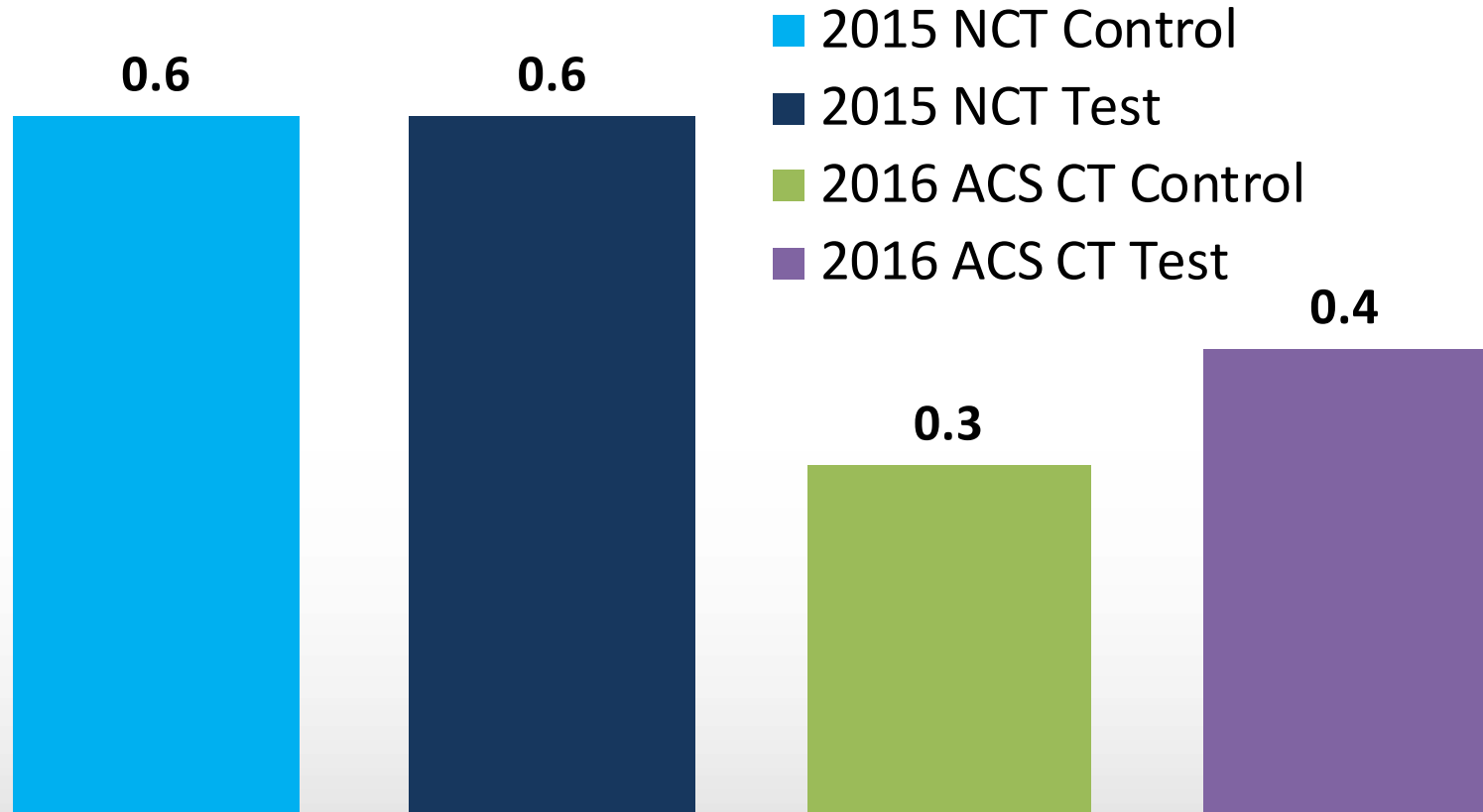

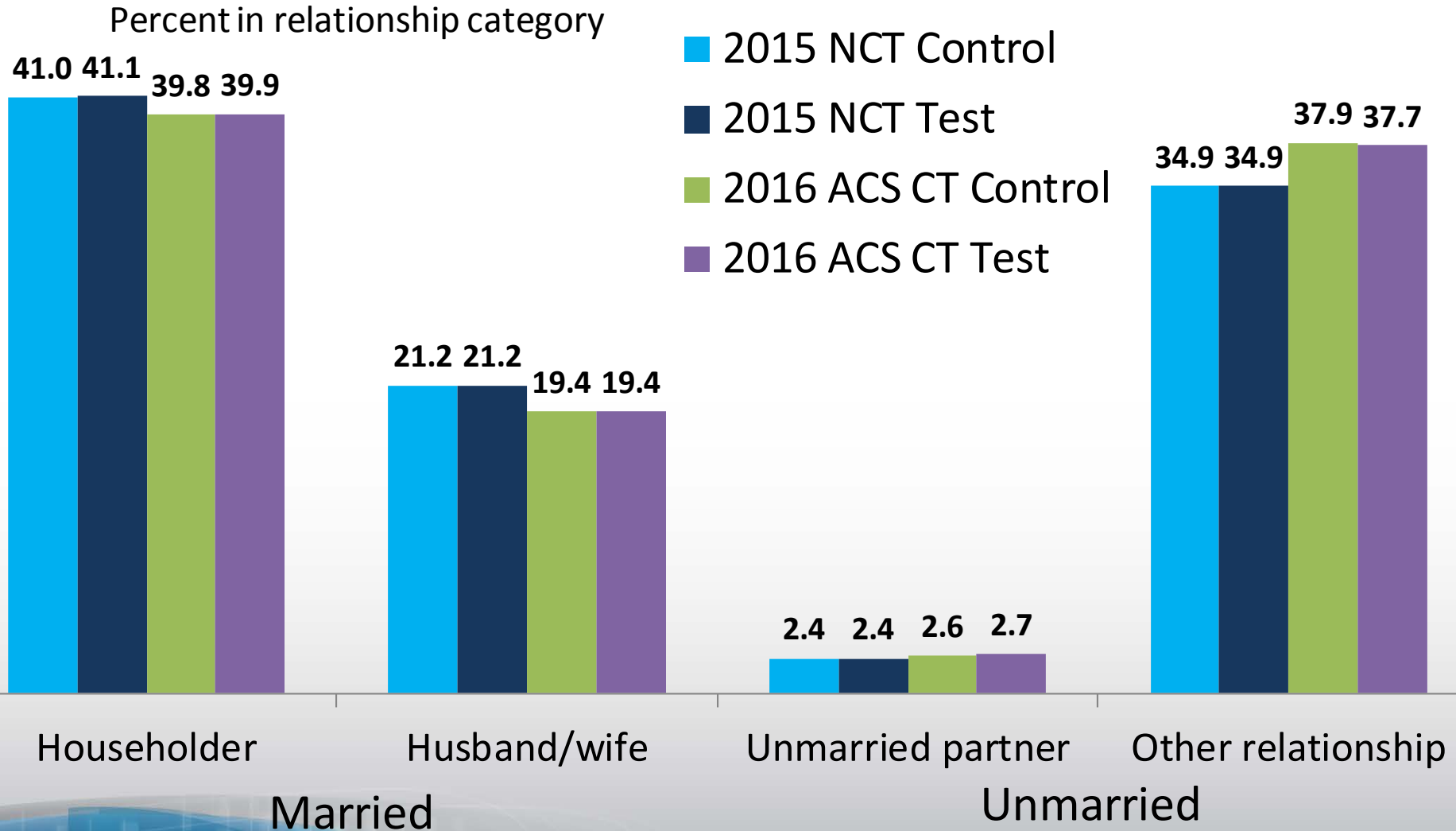
# Figure 3. Item non-response does not differ between test and control

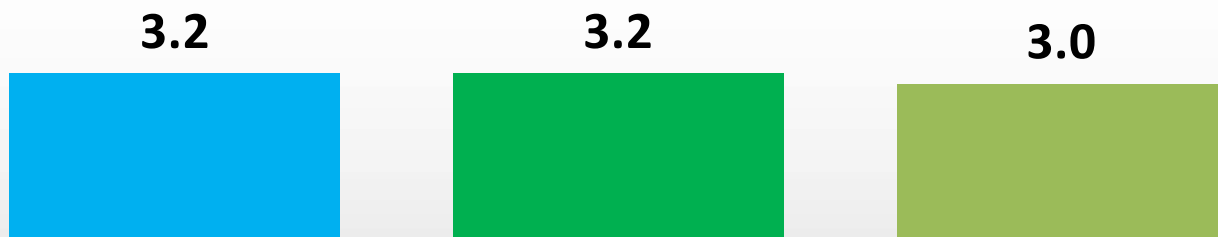

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# Figure 6. Percent of Cases Reported as Nonrelatives, by Treatment Type: 2016 Census Test

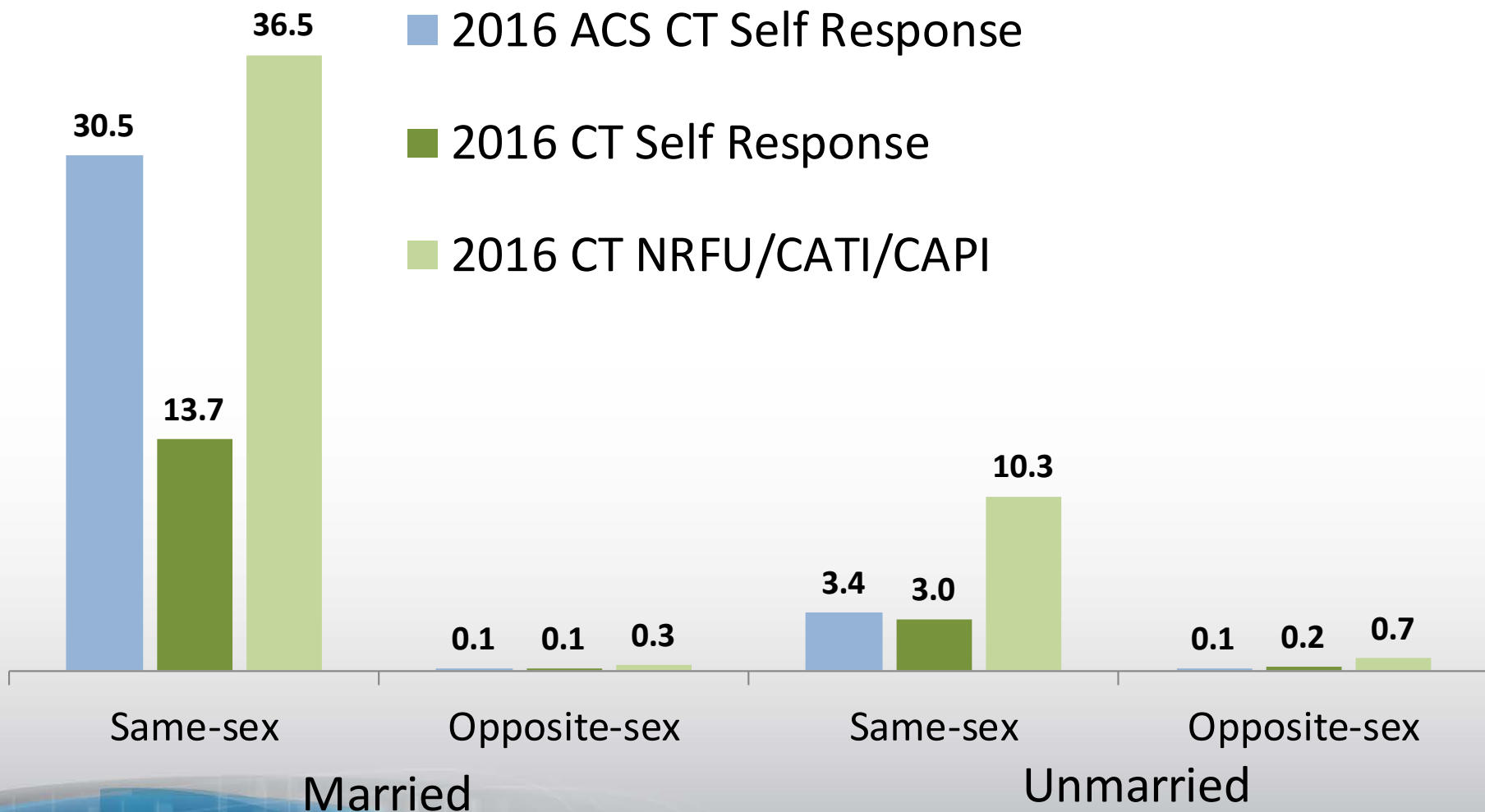

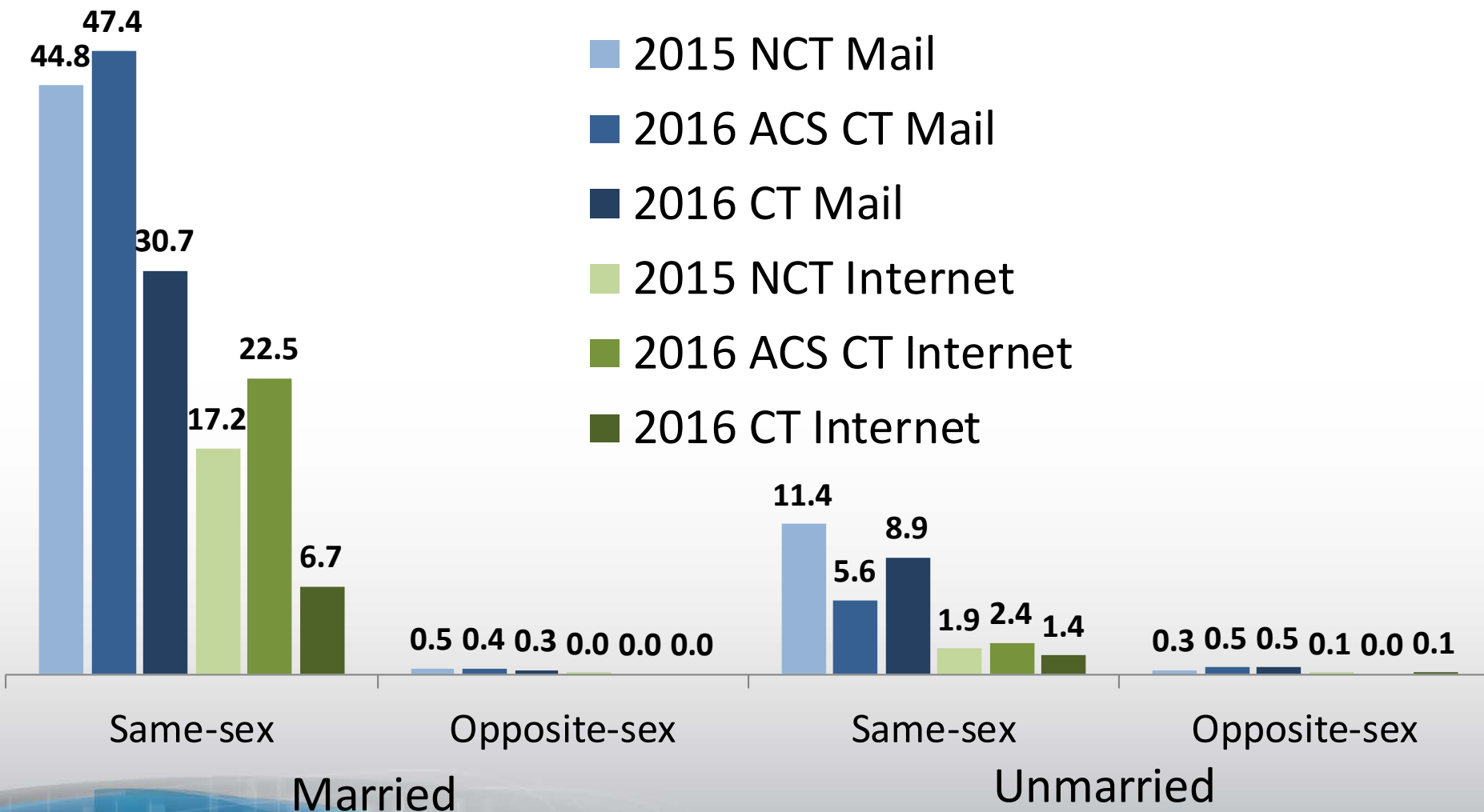

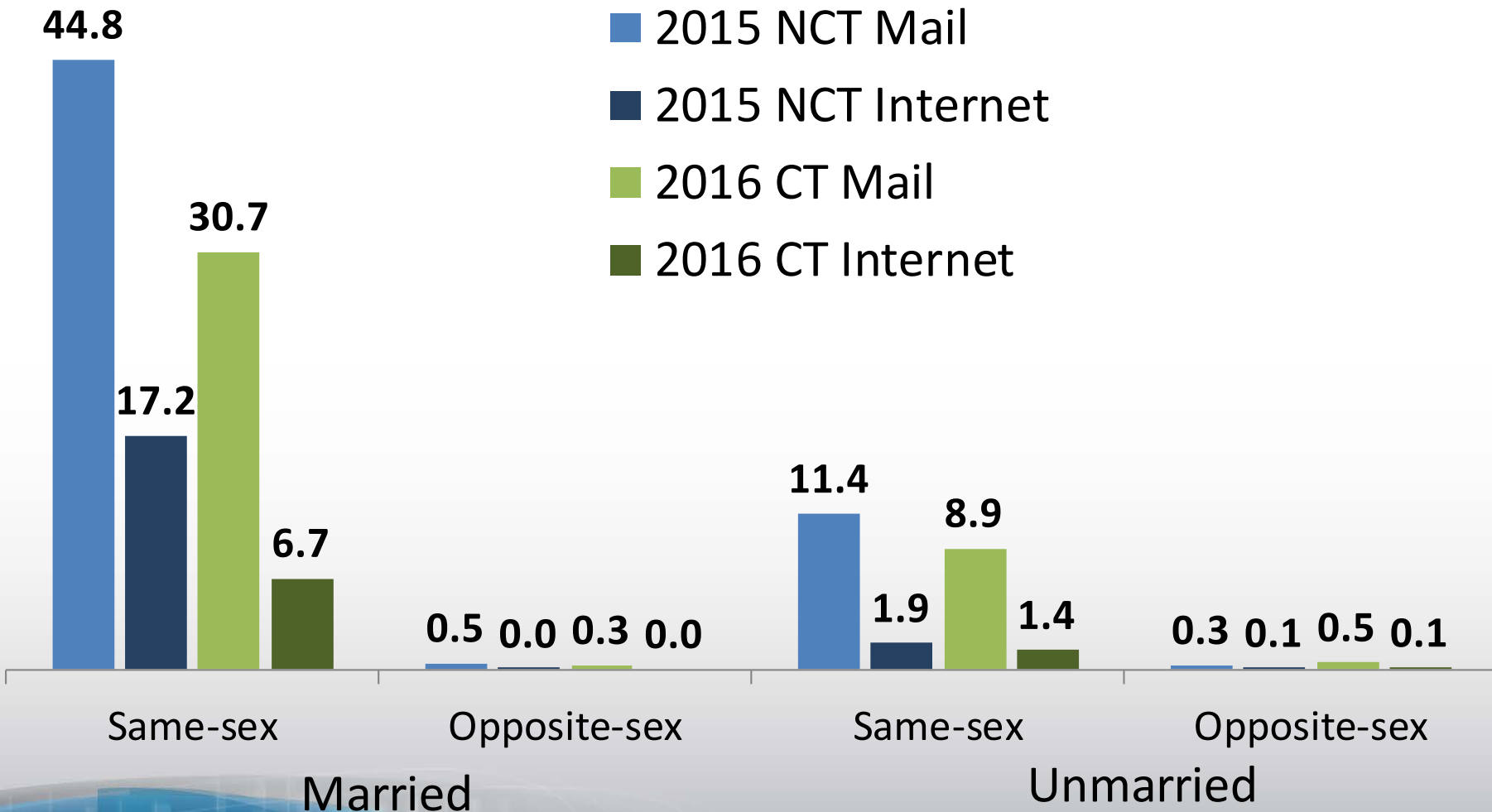
