Stephen Blumberg is the Associate Director for Science for the Division of Health Interview Statistics at the National Center for Health Statistics, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Since 2013, Blumberg has been the principal adviser on scientific matters and oversees division research projects. Previously, he was the senior scientist and lead statistician for the State and Local Area Integrated Telephone Survey. This random-digit-dial survey mechanism regularly fielded some of the world's largest telephone surveys on children's health, health care and well-being, including the National Survey of Children with Special Health Care Needs and the National Survey of Children's Health. He has written and spoken extensively about the prevalence of wireless-only households and the impact of cell phones on coverage bias for telephone surveys.

In 2008, Blumberg received the Young Professional Achievement Award from the Coalition for Excellence in Maternal and Child Health Epidemiology. In 2009, he received the Warren J. Mitofsky Innovators Award from the American Association for Public Opinion Research (AAPOR) and, in 2012, was elected president of the association's Washington-Baltimore chapter.

Blumberg has a doctorate in social psychology from the University of Texas.
