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Event History Calendars

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What is an event history calendar (EHC)?

- An EHC interview is centered around a customized calendar that shows the reference period under investigation
- •The calendar contains timelines for different domains, for example, residence history, household composition, work history, and other domains relevant to the topic of study
- •Landmark events, such as holidays and birthdays can be used to aid the respondent's memory

- An additional group will be created by the universe which matches to administrative records in the validation phase of the analysis.



- Evaluate the characteristics of the survey respondents matching and not matching administrative records by domain.


2008 EHC Evaluation Test
