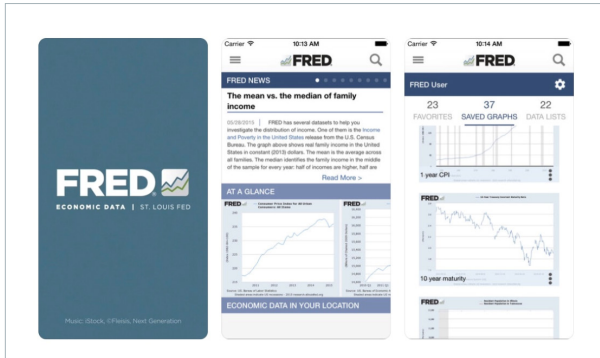


Economic Indicators Now in FRED!

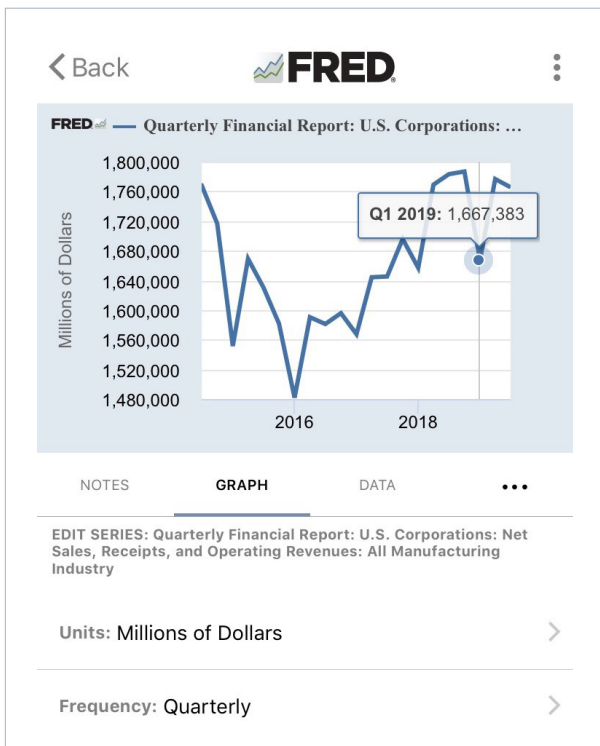


FRED allows users to download, graph, and track over 790,000 U.S. and international time series from more than 100 sources. From FRED, you can browse data by:
