### DID YOU KNOW?


While the Manufacturing sector was the largest employer in the Los Angeles metro area, the Wholesale Trade sector reported the highest 2007 sales (\$ 465.5 Billion). The Los Angeles metro was ranked 1st among U.S. metros in the number of businesses in the Manufacturing sector (20,509 establishments).


