## New York-Northern New Jersey-Long Island, NY-NJ-PA Metro Area


### DID YOU KNOW?

While the Health Care and Social Assistance sector was the largest employer in the New York metro area, the Wholesale Trade sector reported the highest 2007 sales (\$ 643.1 Billion). The New York metro was ranked 1st among U.S. metros in the number of businesses in the Health Care and Social Assistance sector (55,243 establishments).
