Improving Survey Monitoring – Extending Computer Audio Recorded Interviewing (CARI)

QUEST

- Interview quality evaluation system
- Web-based system for reviewing audio data recorded in both field and phone interviews
 - √ Tied into our call center's VOIP system
 - ✓ Also being used for live monitoring in the RTI Call Center using the same evaluation interface
- Applies similar quality metrics to phone and field interviews
- Performance can be tracked across projects
- Standardizes evaluation, feedback and coaching
- Interface designed for supervisors, project staff and clients



Extending Survey Utilities

DOCMAN – Electronic Field Document Capture

- First developed to electronically capture and transmit consent forms and signatures
- Interviewers can now keep electronic case-notes
- Secures electronic locating information
- Information moves seamlessly with case transfers

CATI Case Management Improvements

- Tighter integration between CMS and the I3 VOIP phone system
- Preview dialer automatically sets event code
- Improved interface has significantly reduced hours per complete

Extending our Data Collection Platforms

General Survey System (GSS) For Handheld Data Collection

- Added GPS capability
- Table-driven language
- Developed a PC-based design environment for non-programmers
- Now supports over 30 languages and associated fonts

Hatteras

- Combines field, web and telephone survey in one authoring system and single data source
- Supports multiple hosting locations
- > 508 Compliant
- Integrates with our FIPS-moderate compliant computing environment
- Developed a "non-linear" engine which allows free navigation using a expandable form/item tree
- Being used for medical abstraction surveys

Enhanced Security Network (ESN)

- Computing Infrastructure with Authority to Operate (ATO)
 - compliant with FIPS-moderate requirements
 - Controls access 2-factor authentication
 - > Encryption in transit
 - Audit trails
- Survey systems are compliant
 - Hatteras
 - Integrated Field Management System (IFMS)
 - > CATI
 - CATI Case management system
 - Tracing systems
- Multiple projects data collection utilizing the ESN
