The American Community Survey (ACS)

- On-going survey in U.S. and Puerto Rico designed to provide reliable and timely demographic, social, economic, and housing data every year
- Annual sample allocated into 12 monthly samples of ~250,000 addresses
- Three sequential modes of data collection over a 3month period for each monthly sample
 - Internet introduced as option during mail month



2011 ACS Internet Test Design

- Objective: Determine best method of offering Internet in mail pieces to maximize selfresponse
- Notification Strategies: variety of choice and push strategies
- Tested in two strata: Targeted and Non-Targeted



2011 ACS Internet Test Design

- Timing: April 2011 field test
- CATI Follow-up Interview with 2 components
 - Attitudes and Behavior Study
 - Content Reinterview Assessment



Overview of Instrument Design

- Presents stimuli consistent with other modes while taking advantage of technology.
- Follows a linear path with one question per screen to help navigate skip patterns.
- Topic-based for basic demographic questions, person-based for detailed questions with housing questions in between.



Overview of Instrument Design

- Four rounds of usability testing (focusing on specific features of the instrument)
- 508 compliance
- Collects paradata (click data, breakoffs, help usage, error rendering, etc.)
