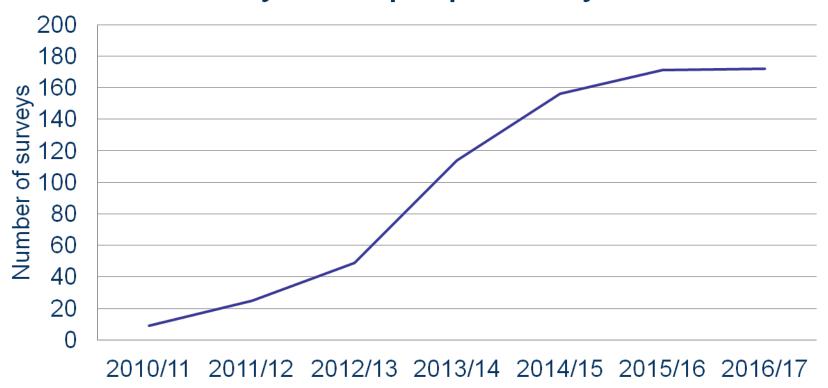
CONTEXT

Surveys developed per fiscal year



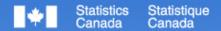

 - Etc.

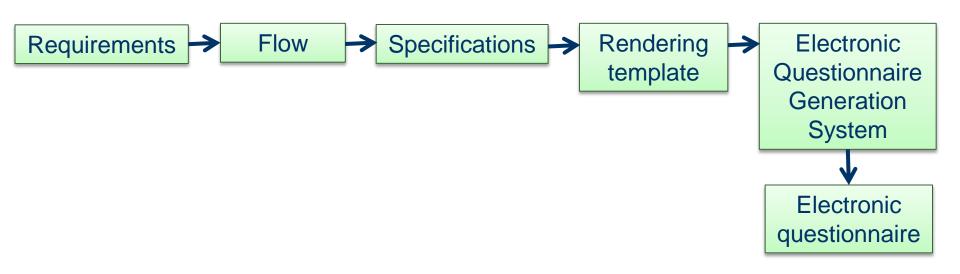

 - Standard change management process





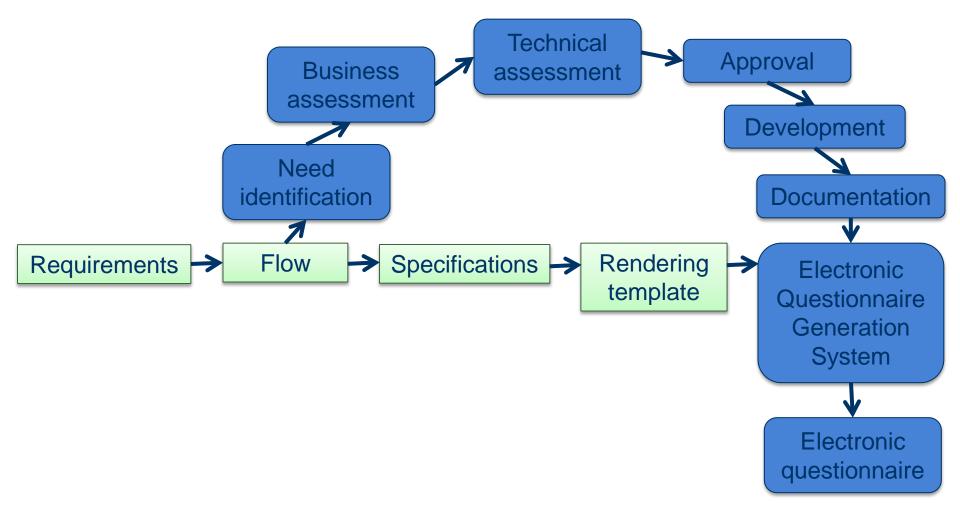
DESIGN PROCESS







CHANGE MANAGEMENT PROCESS

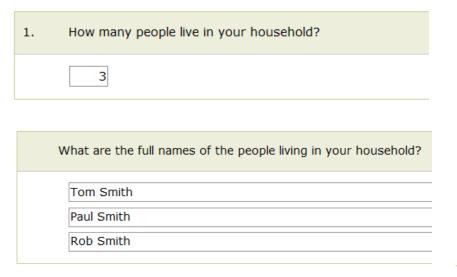

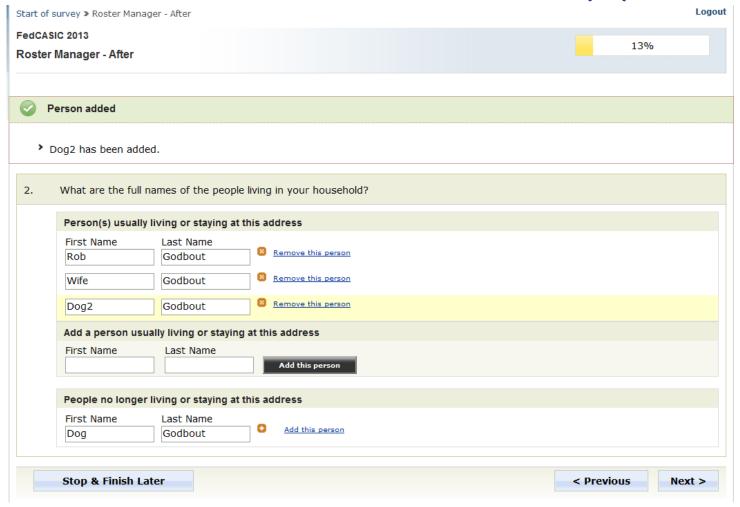

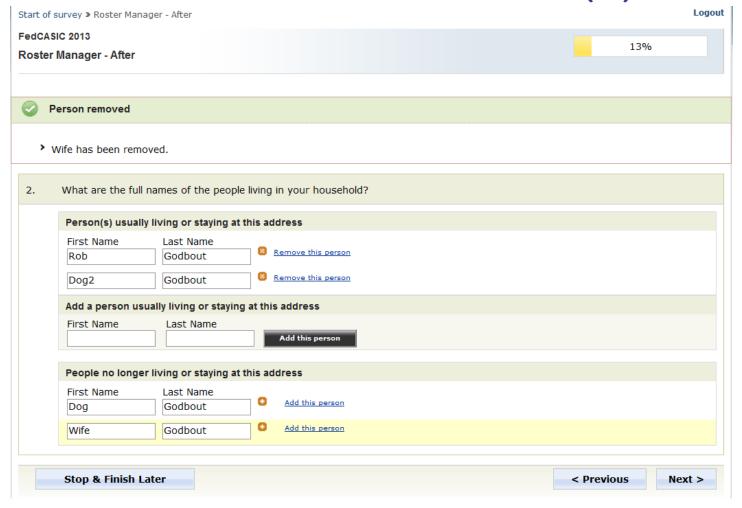

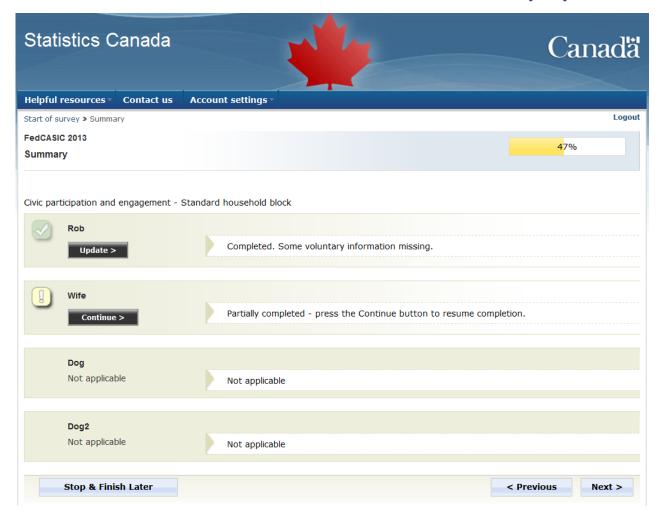
