Paperwork Reduction Act Requirements

- Gathering data from 10 or more persons requires OMB Clearance.
- Agency vehicles
 - Generic Clearance Package
 - Fast Track
- Giving required policy/legal notice




Collection Authority

• Examples:

- Title 13 Census collections
- Title 26 Federal tax data

• Relevance?

- Confidentiality protection required by Title 13 and Title 26.
- Check your agency's authority and the associated confidentiality protections.



Confidentiality Protections: Requirements (1)

- Legal protections
 - Title 13 Census Bureau
 - Title 26 IRS
 - CIPSEA Other Statistical Agencies
 - Others?
- What does YOUR agency require?



Confidentiality Protections: Requirements (2)

- Do you need to collect Personally Identifiable Information (PII)?
 - Name, Address, Date of Birth, Phone, etc.
 - Combined data elements can be identifiable
- What would be the real and/or perceived harm of a data breach?



Confidentiality Protections: Expectations

- Public Perceptions
 - How do your respondents expect their data will be protected?
 - What would the impact be of a data breach?
 - Could there be harm to participants?




Mapping Policy to Practice

Needs:

- Title 13 Confidentiality Protection
- Ability to collect PII

Solutions:

- 1. Internally developed/controlled system
- 2. 3rd party system that would run on our own servers (Standards Working Group)
- 3. 3rd party system that has completed FedRAMP moderate certification and our own Authority to Operate process



Conclusions

- Agency by agency assessment
- Important to assess both real and perceived risks
