 - a. Pronounced core-ray-oh








Fun fact

Choréo – Multimode Management

- 1. Blaise 5 multimode management, that
- 2. Fits easily into an institute's infrastructure, where
- 3. Choréo is value added, that
- 4. Is general and built on common principles, while
- 5. Allowing institutes to keep coding schemes, that
- 6. Is implemented through specification, where
- 7. Choréo is extensible by the institute, and
- 8. Applies to person and household surveys, and
- 9. Collects massive case-level paradata



Timeline: In 2021

- 1. Beta for Blaise institute testing in Autumn 2021
- 2. Massive automated testing now through 2021

How used: By an institute

- As a model for concepts
- 2. As a paradata coordinating utility
 - a. Standardizes paradata formats across modes
- 3. As an advisor about what to do next
- 4. As an automated instruction generator
- 5. Blaise 5 CATI and CMA are hooked in



Choréo use of Tokens

- 1. Choréo programmed in terms of tokens
 - a. Institute can use its own codes and descriptions
 - b. Institute can add happening and action records
