POPULATION OF MISSOURI BY COUNTIES AND MINOR CIVIL DIVISIONS.

This bulletin, prepared under the direction of Mr. WILLIAM C. HUNT, chief statistician for population, gives the aggregate population of Missouri by counties and minor civil divisions, according to the official count of the returns of the Twelfth Census, taken as of June 1, 1900.

Missouri was organized as a territory December 7, 1812, and admitted as a state August 10, 1821. Table 1 shows the population of Missouri at each census from 1810 to 1900, inclusive, together with the increase by number and per cent during each decade.

The population of the state in 1900 is 3,106,665 as compared with a population in 1890 of 2,679,184, showing an increase since 1890 of 427,481, or 16.0 per cent. This is the lowest rate of increase which has appeared for any decade in the history of the state, and it is also observed that the rate of increase for each preceding decade (with one exception) has declined with substantial uniformity. The greatest numerical increase occurred in the decade from 1860 to 1870, in which period the population was augmented by 539,288. More than half a million was also added to the population of the state during the ten years from 1880 to 1890.

The population of Missouri in 1900 is more than 149 times as large as the population given in 1810, the first census in which the population of the territory now comprising the state of Missouri was reported separately.

The total land surface of Missouri is, approximately, 68,735 square miles, the average number of persons to the square mile at the censuses of 1890 and 1900 being as follows: 1890, 39.0; 1900, 45.2.

Table 2 shows the population of Missouri by counties at each census from 1810 to 1900, inclusive, while table 3, which immediately follows, shows, for each county, the increase (or decrease) by number and per cent during the ten years from 1890 to 1900.

There have been no territorial changes in the counties of Missouri since 1890.

Of the 115 counties in the state all but 20 have increased in population since 1890, the counties showing an increase of more than 50 per cent being Pemiscot, 102.8 per cent; Buchanan, 73.8 per cent; Jasper, 66.4 per cent; Butler, 65.0 per cent; and Ripley, 54.9 per cent.

The 20 counties showing a decrease in population are Audrain, Barton, Bates, Clay, Cooper, Dekalb, Grundy, Henry, Iron, Johnson, Knox, Monroe, Montgomery, Morgan, Pike, Platte, Ralls, Randolph, Saline, and Schuyler.

Table 4 shows the population of Missouri by minor civil divisions, so far as it was separately returned at the censuses of 1890 and 1900.

Of the above named 553 incorporated places there are 67 which have a population of more than 2,000; and of these 42 have less than 5,000; 18 have more than 5,000 and less than 10,000; 3 have more than 10,000 and less than 25,000; and 4 have more than 25,000, namely, St. Louis, with 575,238; Kansas City, with 163,752; St. Joseph, with 102,979; and Joplin, with 26,023 inhabitants.

For the 4 cities having a population in 1900 of more than 25,000 a summary is presented in table 6, showing the population of these cities from 1820 to 1900, inclusive, so far as it is separately stated in the census reports at each decennial period, together with the increase by number and per cent during each decade.

According to the above summary the population of St. Louis, beginning with 10,049 in 1820, increased by moderate stages to 16,469 in 1840, then to 77,860 in 1850, then to 160,773 in 1860, and to 310,864 in 1870. Following these 3 decades of rapid progress the rate of increase was slight for the decade from 1870 to 1880, and since then has been normal for a city of its magnitude. Kansas City and St. Joseph each made its first appearance in the census report of 1860. At that census Kansas City had a population of 4,418, which in 1870 had increased to 32,260, or 630.2 per cent, and St. Joseph during the same interval increased in population from 8,932 to 19,565, or 119.0 per cent. During the next decade the greatest increase in population came to Kansas City when it was 137.9 per cent, and to St. Joseph during the decade from 1890 to 1900, when it was 96.8 per cent. The most conspicuous example of gain in population during the last decade is afforded by the city of Joplin, which had 9,948 inhabitants in 1890 and 26,023 in 1900, representing a gain of 161.7 per cent.
