HUNTERDON.—Parts of Bethlehem township and Glen Gardner borough annexed to Hampton borough, and part of Union township annexed to Clinton town, in 1931. MIDDLESEX.—Part of Madison township annexed to Monmouth County in 1939. MONMOUTH.—Part of Middlesex County annexed to Matawan borough in 1939. County total for 1920 includes population (2,682) of Eatontown township, taken to form Oceanport and Eatontown boroughs in 1920 and 1926, respectively. Parts of Neptune and Wall townships annexed to Belmar borough in 1931. Parts of Matawan township annexed to Matawan borough in 1931 and 1933; part of Raritan township annexed to Keansburg borough, and part of Middletown township annexed to Keyport borough, in 1939. Jersey Homesteads borough incorporated from part of Millstone township in 1937. MORRIS.—Part of Randolph township annexed to Dover town in 1938. Chester borough incorporated from part of Chester township in 1930. OCEAN.—Island Beach borough incorporated from part of Berkeley township in 1933. SOMERSET.—Name of Green Brook township changed from North Plainfield in 1932.
