## REAPPORTIONMENT UNDER THE SECOND ENUMERATION

(Act of January 14, 1802--- 2 U.S. Stat. Pt. 1, p. 128)

Chap. 1.--- An Act for the Apportionment of Representatives among the several States according to the second enumeration.(a)

Be it enacted, etc., That from and after the third day of March, one thousand eight hundred andthree, the House of Representatives shall be composed of members elected agreeably to a ratio of one member for every thirty-three thousand persons in each state, computed according to the rule prescribed by the constitution; that is to say: within the state of New Hampshire, five; within the state of Massachusetts, seventeen; within the state of Vermont, four; within the state of Rhode Island, two; within the state of Connecticut, seven; within the state of New York, seventeen; within the state of New Jersey, six; within the state of Pennsylvania, eighteen; within the state of Delaware, one; within the state of Maryland, nine; within the state of Virginia, twenty-two; within the state of North Carolina, twelve; within the state of South Carolina, eight; within the state of Georgia, four; within the state of Kentucky, six; and within the state of Tennessee, three members.
