DID YOU KNOW?

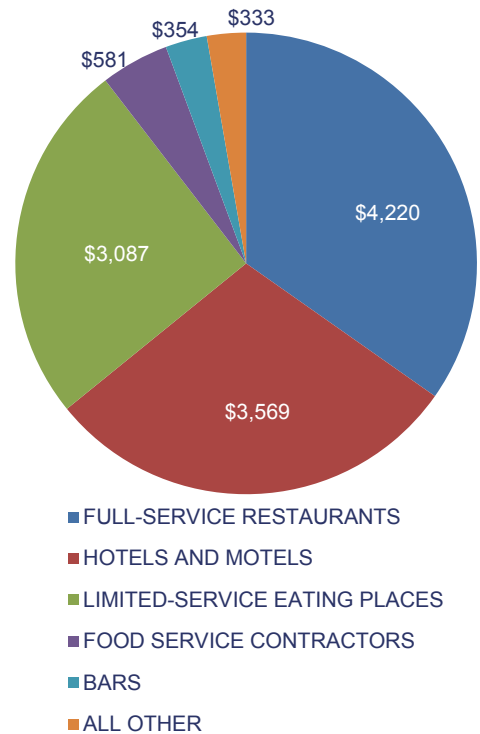
While the Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services sector was the largest employer in the San Francisco metro area, the Wholesale Trade sector reported the highest 2007 sales (\$111.8 Billion). The San Francisco metro was ranked 7th among U.S. metros in the number of businesses in the Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services sector (18,935 establishments).



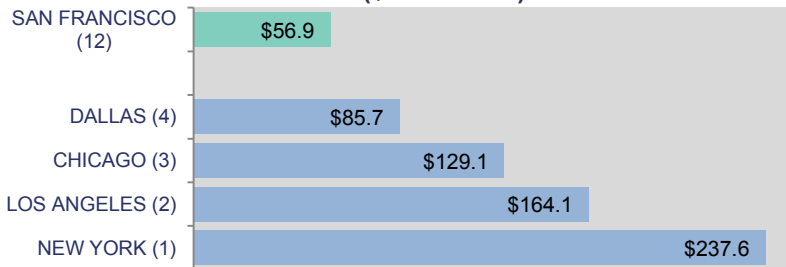
