Advance Report on Durable Goods Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders December 2005

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in December increased \$2.8 billion or 1.3 percent to \$228.1 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau announced today. This was at the highest level since the series was first stated on a NAICS basis in 1992 and followed a 5.4 percent November increase. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 0.9 percent. Excluding defense, new orders increased 0.8 percent.

Machinery, up five consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$1.9 billion or 6.5 percent to \$30.5 billion. This was at the highest level since the series began.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in December, up four of the last five months, increased \$7.5 billion or 3.5 percent to \$221.1 billion. This was at the highest level since the series began and followed a 0.6 percent November increase.

Transportation equipment, up four of the last five months, had the largest increase, \$3.9 billion or 6.5 percent to \$63.4 billion. The increase was led by motor vehicles and parts.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in December, up eight consecutive months, increased \$14.8 billion or 2.4 percent to \$637.3 billion. This was at the highest level since the series began and followed a 3.2 percent November increase.

Transportation equipment, up eight consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$13.7 billion or 4.3

percent to \$329.7 billion. The increase was led by nondefense aircraft and parts.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in December, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.1 billion to \$285.6 billion. This followed a 0.6 percent November increase.

Primary metals, up following six consecutive monthly decreases, had the largest increase, \$0.2 billion or 0.7 percent to \$24.0 billion.

Capital Goods

Nondefense new orders for capital goods in December decreased \$0.5 billion or 0.6 percent to \$87.2 billion. Shipments increased \$3.2 billion or 4.6 percent to \$72.9 billion. Unfilled orders increased \$14.3 billion or 4.3 percent to \$344.2 billion. Inventories decreased \$0.2 billion or 0.2 percent to \$113.3 billion.

Defense new orders for capital goods in December decreased slightly or 0.2 percent to \$6.8 billion. Shipments increased \$0.2 billion or 2.8 percent to \$8.1 billion. Unfilled orders decreased \$1.3 billion or 0.9 percent to \$132.1 billion. Inventories increased slightly or 0.2 percent to \$15.6 billion.

Revised November Data

Revised seasonally adjusted November figures for all manufacturing industries are: new orders, \$409.9 billion (revised from \$407.7 billion); shipments, \$398.2 billion (revised from \$397.0 billion); unfilled orders, \$622.6 billion (revised from 621.4 billion); and total inventories, \$467.6 billion (revised from \$467.1 billion).

Based on advance sample. Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories, and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, whic includes errors of coverage, response and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). The M3 includes approximately 4,200 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 59 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of those companies in the monthly survey effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 62 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 4,200 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 4,200 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source.
