Advance Report on Durable Goods Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders March 2006

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in March increased \$13.3 billion or 6.1 percent to \$230.6 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau announced today. This was the fifth increase in the last six months and followed a 3.4 percent February increase. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 2.8 percent. Excluding defense, new orders increased 6.0 percent.

Transportation equipment, up five of the last six months, had the largest increase, \$9.0 billion or 14.0 percent to \$73.3 billion. The increase was led by nondefense aircraft and parts, which increased \$8.8 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in March, up five of the last six months, increased \$0.6 billion or 0.3 percent to \$219.9 billion. This followed a 0.4 percent February increase.

Machinery, up following two consecutive monthly decreases, had the largest increase, \$0.9 billion or 3.2 percent to \$28.9 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in March, up ten of the last eleven months, increased \$18.0 billion or 2.8 percent to \$661.6 billion. This was at the highest level since the series was first stated on a NAICS basis in 1992 and followed a 1.0 percent February increase.

Transportation equipment, up ten of the last eleven months, had the largest increase, \$13.9 billion or 4.2 percent to \$347.1 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in March, up six of the last seven months, increased \$2.0 billion or 0.7 percent to \$289.4 billion. This followed a 0.4 percent February decrease.

Computer and electronic products, up two of the last three months, had the largest increase, \$1.0 billion or 2.3 percent to \$46.5 billion.

Capital Goods

Nondefense new orders for capital goods in March increased \$9.0 billion or 12.1 percent to \$83.2 billion. Shipments increased \$0.5 billion or 0.7 percent to \$71.4 billion. Unfilled orders increased \$11.8 billion or 3.4 percent to \$362.4 billion. Inventories increased \$0.3 billion or 0.2 percent to \$115.0 billion.

Defense new orders for capital goods in March increased \$1.2 billion or 12.6 percent to \$10.6 billion. Shipments increased \$0.2 billion or 2.7 percent to \$8.2 billion. Unfilled orders increased \$2.4 billion or 1.8 percent to \$131.7 billion. Inventories increased \$0.2 billion or 1.0 percent to \$15.7 billion.

Revised February Data

Revised seasonally adjusted February figures for all manufacturing industries are: new orders, \$403.0 billion (revised from \$401.9 billion); shipments, \$405.0 billion (unchanged from last month); unfilled orders, \$643.6 billion (revised from \$642.4 billion); and total inventories, \$473.6 billion (revised from \$473.8 billion).

Based on advance sample. Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories, and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, whic includes errors of coverage, response and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. Further details on survey design methodology, and data limitations are contained in our most recent annual benchmark publication, Current Industrial Reports: M3-3(04), "Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders: 1992-2004

Survey Description

This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), and end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value). The M3 includes approximately 4,200 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 59 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of those companies in the monthly survey effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 62 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 4,200 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 4,200 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of company or divisional reports to estimate the monthly change for establishments is one source of nonsampling error. The use of primarily large companies to represent the month-to-month movement of all companies is another potential source.

- adjusting new orders and order backlog to be consistent with the benchmarked shipments and inventory data;
- correcting monthly data for late receipts, reclassifications of reported data, and revisions to previously reported data; and
- updating the seasonal adjustment factors for all series.
