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Advance Report on Durable Goods Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders November 2013

New Orders

New orders for manufactured durable goods in November increased \$8.2 billion or 3.5 percent to \$241.6 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau announced today. This increase, up three of the last four months, followed a 0.7 percent October decrease. Excluding transportation, new orders increased 1.2 percent. Excluding defense, new orders increased 3.5 percent.

Transportation equipment, also up three of the last four months, led the increase, \$6.3 billion or 8.4 percent to \$81.2 billion. This was led by nondefense aircraft and parts, which increased \$3.9 billion.

Shipments

Shipments of manufactured durable goods in November, up four consecutive months, increased \$4.1 billion or 1.8 percent to \$238.3 billion. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis in 1992, and followed a 0.6 percent October increase.

Machinery, also up four consecutive months, led the increase, \$1.5 billion or 4.5 percent to \$35.6 billion.

Unfilled Orders

Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in November, up nine of the last ten months, increased \$10.5 billion or 1.0 percent to \$1,058.5 billion. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis, and followed a 0.6 percent October increase.

Transportation equipment, up three consecutive months, led the increase, \$8.4 billion or 1.3 percent to \$654.3 billion.

Inventories

Inventories of manufactured durable goods in November, up seven of the last eight months, increased \$1.2 billion or 0.3 percent to \$384.7 billion. This was at the highest level since the series was first published on a NAICS basis, and followed a 0.3 percent October increase.

Transportation equipment, up eighteen of the last nineteen months, led the increase, \$0.5 billion or 0.4 percent to \$120.8 billion.

Capital Goods

Nondefense new orders for capital goods in November increased \$7.5 billion or 9.4 percent to \$88.0 billion. Shipments increased \$1.0 billion or 1.3 percent to \$75.0 billion. Unfilled orders increased \$13.0 billion or 2.1 percent to \$636.6 billion. Inventories increased \$1.0 billion or 0.5 percent to \$175.1 billion.

Defense new orders for capital goods in November increased \$0.5 billion or 6.3 percent to \$9.2 billion. Shipments increased \$0.9 billion or 9.6 percent to \$10.8 billion. Unfilled orders decreased \$1.6 billion or 0.9 percent to \$165.3 billion. Inventories decreased \$0.5 billion or 2.1 percent to \$22.5 billion.

Revised October Data

Revised seasonally adjusted October figures for all manufacturing industries were: new orders, \$489.1 billion (revised from \$486.9 billion); shipments, \$489.8 billion (revised from \$489.3 billion); unfilled orders, \$1,048.0 billion (revised from \$1,046.2 billion); and total inventories \$633.6 billion (revised from \$633.5 billion).

Figures in text are adjusted for seasonality, but not for inflation. Figures on new and unfilled orders exclude data for semiconductor manufacturing. This report is compiled from results of the U.S. Census Bureau's Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories, and Orders (M3) survey. This survey provides statistics on manufacturers' value of shipments, new orders (net of cancellations), end-of-month order backlog (unfilled orders), end-of-month total inventory (at current cost or market value), and inventories by stage of fabrication (materials and supplies, work-in-process, and finished goods). The M3 includes approximately 4,300 reporting units. Units may be divisions of diversified large companies, large homogenous companies, or single-unit manufacturers in 89 industry categories. Due to the small monthly sample, these 89 categories have been combined into 65 publication levels. The survey methodology assumes that the month-to-month changes of the total operations of the scale companies in the monthly survey effectively represent the month-to-month movements of all establishments that make up the category. The current coverage levels in the survey show that reported data in the monthly survey represent approximately 60 percent of the shipments estimates at the total manufacturing level. Data published represent manufacturing in a calendar month. The data collection is based on a voluntary survey authorized by Title 13 of the United States Code.

The data presented in this release are based on data obtained from a panel of 4,300 reporting units and provide an indication of the activity within the manufacturing sector. The results differ from what would be obtained from a complete enumeration of all manufacturing companies. In addition, a different panel of 4,300 companies would yield different results. The M3 panel is comprised of companies with \$500 million or more in shipments and a limited number of smaller companies. From a statistical perspective, the panel is not a probability sample; therefore, the sampling errors that are normally provided with sample surveys cannot be measured. Nonsampling errors are attributable to many sources. The use of companies is another potential source. Any corrections will be published in the full report. Corrections received after the full report will be released in the next month's advance report. Any revisions made later than two months will be reflected in the annual benchmark publication.
